# Community Partnerships




Amy Osborne from the Marion County Historical Society visited 3rd grade classes at GES during their unit on Native Americans.

# Student Success




MCMS 8th grader Layla Followell was a winner in her age division in the Frank X. Walker Creative Arts Contest for her entry in the visual art category.






MCHS 12th grader McKenna Thomas had her banner design selected to be put on display at the annual KSBA conference.
