### **Curriculum Update: Math HQIR Adoption**

Middle school math teachers are piloting select units from Amplify Desmos across grade levels, including high school offerings. On March 20th, the team will meet with a representative from Great Minds to learn more about the Eureka math curriculum resource. A parent survey is going home this week with curriculum resources posted to our website for feedback after spring break.

### **Curriculum Update: Advanced Coursework Plan for ELA**

Middle school ELA teachers have identified the advanced standards and instructional strategies that will form the foundation for Advanced Coursework implementation in ELA next year. Differentiation strategies include: curriculum compacting, flexible grouping, product choice, tiered assignments, and personalized learning. Specific examples in each domain of ELA include the addition of cross text analysis for reading, tiered writing rubrics, personalized vocabulary development, choice boards to demonstrate knowledge, and leadership in student discourse opportunities. Administration has developed a parent communication plan and reviewed selection criteria to be as inclusive as possible. Initial estimates indicate over 70% of APS middle school students will be eligible for Advanced Coursework. Initial communication to families will begin this week.
