PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- As noted last month, Mr. Taylor and I attended an AI session in Covington on 3/16. Mr. Taylor also attended AI sessions at the KAST conference 3/11-3/13.
 - AI is rapidly changing. It is a tool, but one that we need to keep up with as it evolves. I am making it a priority to stay as updated as possible and make sure we are not a step behind in our utilization of the technology and, equally as important, our students have the appropriate access and exposure to know how to use this safely and effectively.
