- 702 KAR 3:110, Document filing dates
- 702 KAR 3:120, Uniform school financial accounting system
- 702 KAR 5:030, Pupil transportation
- 702 KAR 5:110, Vocational pupils, reimbursement for

COMMISSIONER'S RECOMMENDATION:

The Commissioner recommends approval of the certification of 702 KAR 3:100, 702 KAR 3:110, 702 KAR 3:120, 702 KAR 5:030, and 702 KAR 5:110.

KRS 13A.3102 and KRS 13A.3104

BACKGROUND:

Existing Policy:

Pursuant to KRS 13A.3102 and KRS 13A.3104, the above administrative regulations will expire in June 2026 unless the KBE takes action to certify these administrative regulations.

Summary of Issue:
