Consent Agenda Item (Action Item): Retroactively approve contract modifications with Commonwealth of Kentucky for the Kentucky Comprehensive Literacy Grant (KyCL25): Year 1 (modification March 9, 2026) and Year 2 (modification March 23, 2026)

Applicable State or Regulations: KRS 162.90 Powers and Duties of the local board and Floyd County Board of Education Policy 03.2234

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact: Floyd County Schools has been awarded \$260,000 per year for five years pending federal funding availability. Year 1 was previously approved on May 12, 2025. A modification was made to Year 1 grant on March 9, 2026 to reflect an increase of \$5,033.00 in additional funding to meet the grant goals/deliverables and to include the insurance requirements from the Finance Cabinet. Year 2 was previously approved on October 6, 2025. A modification was made to Year 2 grant on March 23, 2026 to reflect an increase of \$7,710.00 in additional funding to meet the grant goals/deliverables and to include the insurance requirements from the Finance Cabinet. There are no associated costs to the district.

History/Background: The Kentucky Department of Education offered a federal grant opportunity known as KyCL25 that focuses on improving literacy PreK – 12th grades. The grant includes funding for purchasing High Quality Instructional Resources (HQIR), Curriculum Based Professional Learning (CBPL), and teacher coaching services. The grant also provides funding family engagement opportunities for PreK – 12th grade students so families may become engaged in the learning process and receive free books for home use. Floyd County Schools has been awarded the grant and will be utilizing grant funding to provide teachers with professional learning, coaching, and resources that will improve literacy instruction for all students PreK – 12th grades.
