FIELD EXPERIENCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MASTER OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE
PATHOLOGY (MSLP) PROGRAM AT MOUNT ST. JOSEPH UNIVERSITY AND KENTON
COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT

Note: Placements will be made by the Director of Clinical Education from the MSLP program to the office or representative designated by the school district (e.g., building administrator, speech-language pathology supervisor, special ed supervisor).

1. Supervising speech-language pathologists (SLPs) are selected collaboratively between the MSLP Director of Clinical Education and the school district.
2. Supervising SLPs will provide the appropriate supervision of the graduate SLP student (standards set by the American Speech-Language Hearing Association) during the field placement experience and participate in the completion of required documents.
3. There will be no reimbursement from Mount St. Joseph University for supervisors of graduate SLP students.
4. Field experiences may be terminated by the school district at any time if the experience is no longer thought to be in the best interest of the school district or the graduate MSLP student.
5. All MSLP students are insured by Mount St. Joseph University during all field and clinical experiences.
6. All MSLP students have completed training for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion, the Family Educational and Rights Privacy Act, and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act.
