

### Instruction & Student Learning

- Students have completed the spring **NWEA MAP assessments**, providing valuable data on student growth and performance across grade levels. (See data below.)
- Teachers are currently analyzing MAP data to identify trends, celebrate student progress, and determine next instructional steps.
- Grade-level teams are engaging in **MTSS (Multi-Tiered System of Supports) meetings** this week to make targeted, data-driven instructional decisions.
  - Identifying students in need of additional support or enrichment
  - Adjusting intervention groups and instructional strategies
  - Ensuring all students receive appropriate levels of support
- Staff are preparing for upcoming end-of-year assessments and events while maintaining a strong focus on high-quality instruction and student engagement.

### School Culture & Student Support

- Classrooms continue to reinforce **TigerPRIDE** expectations and implement **Character Strong** practices to support a positive and supportive school culture.
- The “TigerPRIDE in Action” behavior framework has now been implemented with all 3rd–5th grade students. Data shows a decrease in disrespectful and disruptive behaviors, along with an increase in respectful behavior and more consistent responses when students struggle to meet expectations.
- Students demonstrating positive choices continue to be recognized through classroom celebrations, TigerPRIDE Student of the Month, and Character Strong recognitions.
