Juniors took the ACT on April 21, and we now await the results. This will probably be the last time we take the ACT, unless the state contracts with ACT again. Considering that we were in limbo until October concerning the state required testing and our students' lack of familiarity with the SAT, we felt it necessary to let our juniors have another opportunity with the ACT.

We completed the End of Program assessments for the Career and Technical Education courses. The results were good - not great but good. We had right at a 70% pass rate. A couple of those that did not pass were very close.

We are in the stretch to the KSA, which will be the last fourteen days in the school calendar. Both buildings will begin testing on Tuesday May 5th.

Phase IV of the CSIP/CDIP are due by May 1st. Phase IV encompasses our NTI plan, our LAU plan and the Professional Development Plans. We are having lots of conversations about professional development for next year. We have modified the calendar for next year and have interspersed PD days through the year.

HB 257 was passed by the legislature and signed by the governor. It was modified and the 60% for mandatory implementation was pulled from the bill. As we wade through all of it, we will continue to provide updates.
