Recommendation/Motion: A motion is in order to post-approve a contract with Safefleet-Seon from March 1, 2025 to July 31, 2026.

Background/Rationale: Cameras and GPS systems are critical infrastructure for safe and efficient school bus operations and have been used by the District for many years. Contracts for these services ensure that video evidence is available to deter student misbehavior and to assist school leaders in resolving incidents quickly. GPS tracking provides real-time visibility that supports dispatch decisions and emergency response efforts, and also assists in route development, arrival & departure tracking, missed or delayed stops, and driver accountability and performance metrics. A transition to Safe Fleet/Seon in 2023 has required additional licenses, which have impacted renewal dates. A post-approval is needed for the contract from March 1, 2025, to July 31, 2026.
