Current Proposed Alignment (2027-2028)
Class 3A Region 7 – East Carter, Floyd Central, Lawrence County, Russell
Class 3A Region 8 – Bell County, Clay County, Knox Central, Letcher County Central, Perry County Central, Rockcastle County
Request
In the proposed alignment for the upcoming football season, Region 8 is the only region in 3A with six teams. Its “sister” region only has four teams. Perry County Central would like to request a move to Region 7 to balance these regions at 5 teams each. We have spoken to many of the teams in Region 8, and all agree that it would be better to balance these regions.
Geography
In reviewing the alignment map on the KHSAA website, it appears that either Letcher County Central or Perry County Central could make this move. However, it is a much better fit for Perry Central to make this move because of overall distances to regional games being shorter. It is also more convenient for Perry Central due to the proximity to Highway 80.
Competitive Fairness
If one region has six teams, then two of those teams will not participate in the playoffs, whereas all teams in the 4-team region will be guaranteed a playoff spot regardless of regular season performance. This could penalize a more deserving

team.
