Please mention any other desired comments on behalf of your school: Breckinridge County would like to petition to be moved to Class 4A District 4 from the current District 3 that we have been placed in. The reasoning behind this petition is to ensure that our coaches who drive the bus to transport our players to the game can travel the easiest possible routes. Both of these districts would put us in a 6 team district in the next cycle so that all stays the same as well. In addition travel distances are essentially the same as outlined below.
4A District 3:
John Hardin- 39 Miles
Nelson County- 71 Miles
Taylor County- 78 Miles
Marion County- 91 Miles
Spencer County- 84 Miles
Total Mileage- 363 Miles
4A District 4:
Christian Academy of Louisville- 73 Miles
North Oldham- 80 Miles (Current District)
Shelby County- 90 Miles
Valley- 46 Miles (Current District)
Waggener- 69 Miles (Current District)
Total Mileage- 358 Miles
In addition to the total mileage actually being less in District 4, our coaches will be able to travel familiar better roads in Highway 60, Dixie Highway, Gene Snyder Freeway and Interstate 64 in order to get to all of the schools in District 4. As opposed to smaller, more unfamiliar roads to Marion and Taylor

Counties.

Finally District 4 also allows us to stay with current District teams in North Oldham, Valley and Waggener from our current alignment helping more with familiarity.

In closing we ask for the KHSAA to grant this move for Breckinridge County to District 4 from the current District 3 alignment for the reasons outlined above. Thank you all for your time and consideration.
