Due to geographic proximity, Bullitt East respectfully requests that the Board of Control consider moving Fairdale into District 4 and move Male into District 3. District 3 would be made of PRP, Manual, Male, St.X. District 4 would be made of Fairdale, Southern, Fern Creek, and Bullitt East. There are 12 6A schools in the Jefferson/Bullitt/Oldham area. Of those 12 schools there are three groups of three schools that are in relatively close proximity to one another. The fourth school for each district would be a little farther away, but closer to one group of three than any other. A solution would be to have District 3 be composed of Manual, St. Xavier, Male, and PRP. PRP, to the west, would be a school that is farther away than the other three. District 4 would be composed of schools along the Gene Snyder Freeway, which would be Fairdale, Southern, and Fern Creek. Bullitt East, to the south, would make up the fourth team. District 5 would be composed of Trinity, Ballard, Eastern. Oldham County, to the northeast, would make up the fourth team. Our proposal is based on geographical proximity as well as access to major thoroughfares such as Dixie Highway, I-65, and I-264 (District 3); Bardstown Road and Gene Snyder (District 4); and I-71, I-264, and Shelbyville Road (District 5).
