



This agreement establishes collaboration between the Bourbon County Health Department and Bourbon County High School to provide the comprehensive sexual health “Reducing the Risk” curriculum to students for the **2026-2027** and **2027-2028** school years. Reducing the Risk is an evidence-based, age-appropriate sexual health curriculum aligned with state law and education standards. It focuses on increasing youth social competencies such as decision-making, goal setting, and skill building to decrease negative behaviors, including sexual risk behaviors, substance use, and unhealthy relationships.

To ensure proper instruction time is given to complete the curriculum with fidelity, the school agrees to schedule approximately 50 minutes of instruction time per health class session. The curriculum consists of 16 lessons to be taught over the course of the entire school year, with allowance for schedule adjustments due to weather, illness, and other uncontrollable circumstances.

Bourbon County High School agrees to provide the following:

- Provide notification to students’ parents/guardians at the beginning of the school year (or more than 2 weeks before curriculum implementation) to inform them of the intent of the program to be offered within the school.
- Support in receiving written consent for student participation in the program at least 2 weeks before scheduled education.
- Scheduling of the following classes to receive curriculum education once per week:
 - - Girls: 1st, 2nd, 5th, and 6th periods
 - - Boys: 1st, 2nd, 4th, and 5th periods
- Provide the required amount of time to complete the curriculum with fidelity per the curriculum developer.

Bourbon County Health Department will provide the following:

- A qualified and trained staff member to implement the program with fidelity.
- Evidence-based and medically accurate curriculum instruction aligned with Kentucky Department for Education Standards.
- Staff participate in parental education to ensure the opportunity for the curriculum to be reviewed before education dates.
- Ensure the curriculum is available for full review to interested parties before the start of education.
- There will be no cost to the school for implementation of this program.
- Notify the school of any changes in scheduling or the educator assigned to complete the curriculum as soon as possible.
