This grant, ("Grant") is awarded to Johnson Traditional Middle, ("Grantee"), by Project Lead The Way, Inc. ("PLTW"), with an estimated value of up to \$9,100.00, and is subject to and conditioned upon Grantee's compliance with the following Grant requirements:

A. Active PLTW School; Eligible Programs.

1. This Grant Agreement is conditioned upon the Grantee being deemed an "Active PLTW School" within PLTW's records. To maintain this status throughout each year of the Grant, ("Grant Year"), the Grantee must: (i) have a signed PLTW Terms and Conditions agreement or other PLTW-approved signed written agreement between Grantee or Grantee's District and PLTW on file with PLTW, and (ii) ensure the teacher(s) for the Grant-applicable PLTW Program(s) have successfully completed PLTW Core Training or other PLTW-approved professional development plan, (collectively, "Training"), earned the corresponding credential, and provide instruction for the applicable PLTW Program(s) during each Grant Year. PLTW's Grant Committee will review Grantee's compliance with these requirements on a regular basis during the Grant Period.
2. This Grant may be used only to offset costs required for implementation of the PLTW Gateway Program, ("PLTW Gateway"), as contemplated in this Grant Agreement, and specifically for PLTW Gateway participation fees and PLTW Teacher Training registrations.

B. Grant Period. Subject to Grantee's compliance with this Grant Agreement, the Grant shall commence as of the Grant Period Start Date of and continue in effect until the Grant Period End Date, (hereinafter "Grant Period"). This Grant award will be used during the specific time frames as set forth herein.

C. Grant Specific Terms.

1. **Allowable Costs.** This Grant shall be used to cover the following costs associated with implementation of PLTW Gateway:
 - a. Grant Year 1 PLTW Gateway participation fee;
 - b. Grant Year 2 PLTW Gateway participation fee; and
 - c. PLTW Core Teacher Training registrations for a maximum of six (6) Grantee Teachers.

2. **Grantee Requirements:**
 - a. Grantee will register for PLTW Gateway and ensure a legally authorized and executed PLTW Terms and Conditions agreement is on file with PLTW;
 - b. Grantee will maintain its status as an Active PLTW School for the entire Grant Period;
 - c. Grantee must offer at least one PLTW Gateway unit in the 2026-2027 academic year and must offer one additional different unit in the 2027-2028 academic year. Grantee may implement any PLTW Gateway units of their choosing and must use between one (1) to six (6) PLTW Gateway Core Training seats by October 1, 2028. Grantee is responsible for the 2028-2029 PLTW Gateway participation fee. Additionally, Grantee is required to keep the PLTW Gateway program active for the entire grant period, regardless of program participation.
 - d. Grantee understand and agrees it is required to pay and will pay the Grant Year 3, 2028 - 2029 PLTW Gateway participation fee regardless of whether Grantee offers PLTW Gateway in Grant Year 3. The participation fee amount is \$950.00. Grantee will make such payment within thirty (30) days of receipt of an invoice. PLTW reserves the right to pursue collection efforts on outstanding invoices.

3. Any additional purchases and/or expenses incurred by Grantee and not contemplated in this Grant Agreement will be the responsibility of the Grantee. Grantee agrees to remit payment to PLTW for any such costs within thirty (30) days of receipt of an invoice from PLTW. PLTW reserves the right to pursue collection efforts on outstanding invoices.

4. Grantee understands and agrees that if Grantee is out of compliance with the Grant Agreement at any time during the Grant Period, PLTW may invoice Grantee for any or all of the Allowable Costs as set forth in Section C. Grantee agrees to pay any invoices received from PLTW within thirty (30) days of receipt. PLTW reserves the right to pursue collection efforts on outstanding invoices.

5. Grantee acknowledges and agrees this Grant has no cash value. If Grantee discontinues the PLTW Program or fails to use the allocated Training seats as outlined in this Grant Agreement, the Grant value for any remaining eligible Participation Fees and unused Training seats will be forfeited.

- D. Nonpermissive Use.** If any Grantee Teacher(s) cancels their Core Training registration(s) within seven (7) Core Training start date or fails to successfully complete Core Training and earn the required credential, Grantee will forfeit the associated Core Training seat(s).
- E. Reporting.** Grantee will submit PLTW Grant reports and surveys by April 15 of each Grant year. Grantee's specific reporting requirements can be found in the My Grants Section of myPLTW. Grantee is responsible for submitting complete and timely reports and PLTW will determine satisfactory progress and compliance. PLTW may modify reporting requirements in its sole discretion.
- F. Access To Records.** From time to time, PLTW may require Grantee to provide additional information as part of the Grant requirements or to determine Grant compliance. Grantee will promptly provide such additional information, reports, and documents as PLTW may request and will allow PLTW and its representatives to have reasonable access to files, records, accounts, or personnel that are associated with this Grant, for the purpose of financial reviews, verifications, or assessing Grant progress or compliance, as may be deemed necessary by PLTW. Any such information, reports, documents, or access shall be limited to the audit of the PLTW Program and the Grant and shall be made consistent with any applicable federal or state laws relating to the provision of such information. Grantee's sharing of Confidential Data, as defined in the Data Protection Agreement (DPA) between the Jefferson County Board of Education and PLTW, is governed by the DPA, including compliance with the JCPS IRB process, as noted in the DPA.
- G. PLTW Reporting Obligations, Impact Data.** PLTW may have certain reporting obligations to its grant funder(s) as part of providing the grant to Grantee. PLTW will not share any student personally identifiable data and will not sell student data or use student data for commercial purposes. The Parties agree that PLTW may share the following data with its grant funder(s): Grantee name, aggregate student enrollment numbers, aggregate student demographics, and aggregate information pertaining to completed educator training credits, and components of Program(s) taught. Student enrollment, student demographics, and teacher demographics are aggregated for all PLTW grantees. PLTW may also externally share aggregate program impact data to support its mission as related to grant programs.
- H. Compliance.** PLTW reserves the right to invoice Grantee for up to the entire value of the Grant, may limit access to PLTW curriculum and support resources, and/or may terminate this Grant Agreement if Grantee has not fully complied with the terms and conditions of this Grant Agreement or is not in full compliance at any time during the Grant Period.
- I. Termination.** In the event grant funds are no longer available or if Grantee fails to comply with the terms contained herein, PLTW may, in its sole discretion, terminate this Grant Agreement. In the event of noncompliance, PLTW reserves the right to invoice Grantee for Participation Fees and/or Teacher Training registrations. Grantee will pay all invoices within thirty (30) days of receipt of any such invoice. If the Grant Agreement is terminated, no additional award shall be distributed, and Grantee may be obligated to pay all costs associated with the PLTW Program implementation.
- J. Amendments.** Grantee understands that due legal obligations and/or Program or organizational changes, improvements, circumstances, or developments, PLTW may modify

certain terms or requirements of the Grant from time to time upon reasonable notice to Grantee in a form and delivery method determined by PLTW. Unless otherwise provided in the notice of such changes, the most current terms and requirements shall apply to the Grant and are incorporated by reference into this Grant Agreement.

K. Acceptance and Authorization. PLTW's obligation to provide the Grant contemplated by this Grant Agreement is subject to the availability of funds available for this purpose. In the event of unavailability, this Grant Agreement will automatically terminate, and no additional award amounts will be distributed. Grantee understands and agrees that execution of this document represents both its acceptance of the Grant award subject to full compliance with the terms of this Grant Agreement as well as Grantee's authorization for participation confirmation for the PLTW Program(s) set forth in this document. Grantee acknowledges and agrees the person signing this document is legally authorized to obligate the Grantee to its terms. Grantee agrees this Grant Agreement and the PLTW Terms and Conditions or other PLTW approved signed written agreement between Grantee and PLTW constitutes the entire understanding between the parties regarding the Grant award during the Grant Period. Upon execution of the Grant Agreement, Grantee shall receive written confirmation of the Grant supported PLTW Program(s) contemplated by this Grant Agreement.
