Duties of a Supervising Certified School Psychologist

- Provides direct supervision, mentoring, and professional guidance to an intern school psychologist.
- Assumes additional responsibility for overseeing the intern's clinical and ethical practices.
- Reviews evaluations, reports, and intervention plans to ensure accuracy and compliance with state and district standards.
- Devotes additional time beyond regular duties for supervision meetings, observation, and feedback.
- Ensures interns follow legal, ethical, and NASP (National Association of School Psychologists) guidelines.
- Coordinates communication among universities, district personnel, families, and intern.
- Assists interns in developing assessment, counseling, consultation, and crisis intervention skills
- Takes on increased accountability for student services provided under the intern's supervision
- Provides training in data collection, report writing, and multidisciplinary collaboration
- Uses specialized expertise and licensure to supervise and evaluate professional practice

Stipend Pay Schedule for Certified School Psychologist who will supervise Intern School Psychologist

75.00 per hour – (2 hours weekly)

600.00 monthly

10 months of supervision – August 2026-May 2027 = 6000.00
