Custodial/Maintenance

- Both Summer crews are in the process of deep cleaning both schools.
- They have coordinated schedules to work around summer activities within the buildings.

Project One

- We continue to work on punch list items in order to bring the project to a close.
- Project update meeting is being planned to fully update all remaining items prior to the end of June.

School Safety

- Annual first responder meeting will be planned for early August to review all safety plans.
- We will continue to make in-house improvements based on KCSS recommendations to improve campus security throughout the summer.

Transportation

- We had 27 athletic events and 12 instructional trips in the month of May.
- Fleet upgrades including annual; cleaning and maintenance. Our newer buses, 5 and 6 will be in for warranty work and recall work over the summer.
- Bus 1 is in the process of having the engine rebuilt. After evaluating the availability of purchasing a surplus bus or repairing bus 1 we have decided to proceed with repairing bus 1. This repair will provide us with a viable bus and increase its resale value in the future when we look to purchase an additional bus for the district.

Student Attendance/DPP

- Enrollment as of 5/23/26 was 723 – 361 at LES and 362 at DHS.
- Enrollment as of 5/23/25 was 721 – 372 at LES and 349 at DHS.
- Attendance percentage 5/26: LES – 94.35% DHS – 93.10% District – 93.78%
- Attendance percentage 5/25: LES – 94.43% DHS – 91.87% District – 93.25%
- After adjustment for bad weather days and we expect district attendance to be over 94%
- Nonresident enrollment is currently being evaluated and updated. This is being done to ensure collection of tuition fees where appropriate and verification of space at grade levels.
