Academic Information

- We wrapped up the 2025-2026 school year by celebrating the 138th graduating class of Bellevue High School. Some notable accomplishments of this class includes:
 - Having the highest ACT scores out of all River City schools as Juniors.
 - Having the highest ACT growth out of all high schools in Northern Kentucky.
 - 173 credit hours earned at NKU.
 - 437 credit hours earned at Gateway.
 - 610 total dual credit hours earned.
 - 100% of the class achieved Career and College Readiness.
 - 8 Seniors earned industry certification from the Campbell County ATC.
 - Two Seniors will be enlisting in the military after graduation.
- Scheduling is just about completed for the 2026-2027 school year.
- We wrapped up our summer school/credit recovery program for both middle school and high school students with 20 combined students attending.
