The Board of Education of the Anchorage Independent School District has completed the annual evaluation of Superintendent Six for the 2025-26 school year.

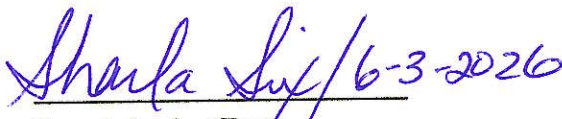
The evaluation focused on three standards of performance and three district goals agreed on by the Board and Superintendent.
