RE: 2026-2027 Code of Acceptable Behavior

The Office of Pupil Personnel requests the Christian County Board of Education to approve the following revisions in the 2025-2026 Code of Acceptable Behavior:

- KRS 158.150 specific due process language revised and added on pages 19,21,& 25
- Under Pranks/Vandalism section added Prohibited from attending Prom page 29
- Add Step 8 to Robbery Theft, Sexual Assault and Sexual Harassment page 40
- Revised Step 8 language from 4 weeks to 20 days (K-5) Discipline pages 38-41
- Refused to be Searched added to the 6-12 Consequences and Options Guidelines Step 8 &9 for high school and Steps 7,8 & 9 middle school page 45
- Revised Violation of Technology Use (no cellphone) from Step 3 to Step 6 page 46
- Added language to include any student who engages in a fight will not be able to attend extracurricular activities. This stipulation includes Prom for high school students pages 42 & 47
- Revised 3rd Degree Assault length of stay to one calendar year pages 50 & 52
- Revised Terroristic Threat length of stay to Superintendent Placement Decision pages 50 & 52
- Added Violation of Personal Electronics and length of stay 25 days pages 51 & 53
