

### **Currently Working On:**

- US Dept of Health and Human Services (US DHHS), Substance Abuse & Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Trauma-Informed Services in Schools Grant; a 4-year grant, up to \$3.88 million to increase student access to evidence-based support services and mental health care. No match required.
- US DOJ COPS School Violence Prevention Program Grant; a 3-year grant, up to \$500,000 grant to improve security at schools and on school grounds through evidence-based school safety programs. Cash match of 25% required.

### **Submitted Grants:**

- US DOJ Community & Schools Youth Drug Prevention Program Grant; ACS GRAD, a 3-year grant, requested \$750,000 to deliver substance use prevention programs for preschool – 12<sup>th</sup> grade. No match required.
- US DOJ STOP School Violence Program Grant; Project SAVE, a 3-year grant, requested \$1,000,000 to hire three full-time Behavior Trainers and Interventionists, expand Threat Assessment Teams, implement a tiered MTSS behavioral framework, provide training for students, staff, and law enforcement, and create a secure, anonymous reporting system. No match required.
