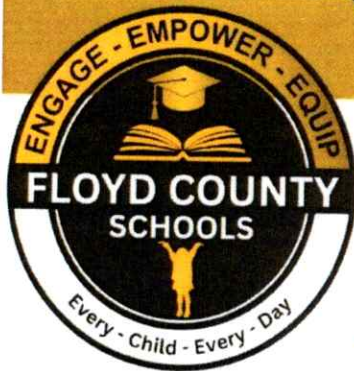

History/Background:

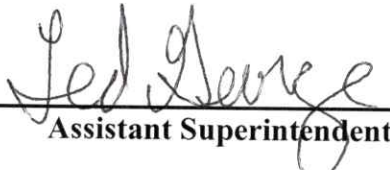
This grant will assist in funding a qualified faculty member to provide dual credit opportunities to students and support their completion of the media arts pathway.

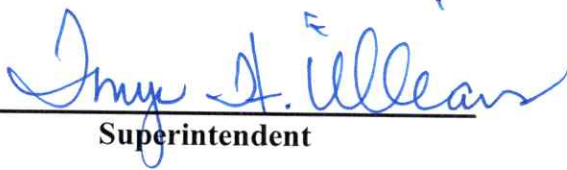

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
BIG SANDY COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE
AND
FLOYD COUNTY SCHOOLS

This Memorandum of Agreement (Agreement), by and between Big Sandy Community and Technical College (BSCTC), a college in the Kentucky Community and Technical College System (KCTCS), and Floyd County Schools is entered into for the purpose of supporting the dual credit media arts pathway between BSCTC and Floyd County Schools.

Both BSCTC and Floyd County Schools agree that it is of mutual benefit to the students and community to fully support a degree pathway provided, in part, by dual credit courses. To achieve this goal, the Parties agree as follows:

I. AGREEMENT TERM AND CANCELLATION

This Agreement is effective from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2027. This Agreement may be extended automatically under the same terms and conditions not to exceed 3 annual extension periods. No extension shall prolong the period of the Agreement beyond June 30, 2030. Either party may cancel this agreement at any time for cause or may cancel without cause on a 30-day written notice.

II. OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Floyd County Schools will use the funds provided by BSCTC to support the employment of a full-time faculty member to support dual credit enrollment in the media arts pathway.

III. FINANCIAL DATA AND TERMS

- BSCTC shall pay no more than \$30,000.00 annually for services as described in this Agreement.
- Floyd County Schools will submit an invoice and all supporting documentation at the conclusion of each fiscal year.
- In the event of cancellation of the Agreement, Floyd County Schools will issue a final invoice for any outstanding costs due through the date of cancellation. BSCTC will pay the final invoice within 30 days of receipt.

IV. EMPLOYMENT

Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as creating an employment relationship between Floyd County School's employee and BSCTC. The full-time faculty member employed by Floyd County Schools is at all times an employee of Floyd County Schools and is not intended or expected to function as an employee of BSCTC and/or KCTCS. Floyd

County Schools is at all times responsible for any salary, tax withholdings, all benefits, insurance, workers compensation, or other privileges and entitlements created by an employment contract.

V. SEVERABILITY

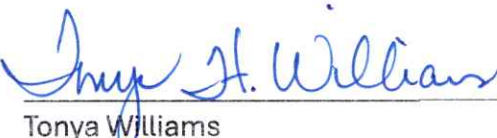
The breach, disagreement concerning, and/or illegality of any single provision of this agreement shall not nullify the entire agreement.

VI. CHOICE OF LAW AND VENUE

Both parties hereby agree that the Kentucky Community and Technical College System (KCTCS), as a public agency, enjoys qualified sovereign immunity. Any litigation arising from the alleged breach of this contract and/or interpretation of the terms of this agreement shall be brought in Franklin Circuit Court. Any negligence claims against KCTCS shall be brought pursuant to KRS 44.070 et seq., the Board of Claims Act. Furthermore, all terms and conditions in this agreement to the contrary notwithstanding, the parties understand and agree that state and federal laws governing KCTCS as a public agency shall prevail.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties hereto have caused their duly authorized representatives to execute this Agreement.
