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Consent Agenda Item (Action Item): Consider/Approve the selection of an architectural firm to provide architectural services for the Betsy Layne High School Softball Field Renovation Project.

Applicable State Law or Regulation: 702 KAR 4:160 – Capital Construction Process

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact: Architectural fees and the project schedule will be established upon completion of the selection process and negotiated in accordance with the A/E Fee Guidelines. The total project budget and funding source will be presented to the Board upon completion of the design phase and approval of the BG-1.

History/Background: The Betsy Layne High School softball facilities require renovation to provide equitable athletic facilities and opportunities for female student-athletes. The proposed project is intended to address facility deficiencies and support the District's ongoing efforts to comply with the requirements of **Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972**, which prohibits discrimination on the basis of sex in educational programs and activities receiving federal financial assistance.

The renovation will evaluate and improve the existing softball facilities to provide a safe, functional, and equitable environment for student-athletes while supporting the long-term needs of the athletic program.

- **June 22:** Board approved advertising for Letters of Interest and Requests for Proposals (RFPs) for architectural and engineering services.
- **July 15:** Letters of Interest and Requests for Proposals were due by 12:00 p.m.
- A selection committee reviewed the submitted qualifications and proposals in accordance with the Capital Construction Process.

Recommended Action: Select and approve an architectural firm to provide architectural services for the Betsy Layne High School Softball Field Renovation Project.
