FY27 General School Fee Structure

To ensure compliance with the Accounting Procedures for Kentucky School Activity Funds (The Redbook), which mandates that all fees and charges levied against students be approved by the local Board of Education. This request establishes a pre-approved fee threshold for standard, co-curricular field trips and day-time school activities that occur during the instructional day. Providing a baseline cap minimizes administrative strain while keeping activities affordable for families and ensuring equitable access.

General Fee Structure & Terms

Field Trips / School Activities (Occurring during the regular school day) Up to \$50.00 per student, per activity

Activities include but are not limited to: Admission tickets, venue entry, specialized instructional materials, general materials and supplies for events, registration fees, and transportation costs.

This fee structure applies to: Huntertown Elementary, Northside Elementary, Simmons Elementary, Southside Elementary, Woodford Co. Middle, Woodford Co. High, Safe Harbor Academy, Woodford Virtual Learning Academy

This blanket approval applies strictly to daytime activities (Occurring during the regular school day) costing \$50.00 or less per student. Any field trip, day activity, or co-curricular event exceeding the \$50.00 threshold must be submitted as a separate item to the Board of Education for individual review and approval before any logistical arrangements are finalized or funds are collected.
