### Description of Items

As best practice requires, we do not surplus items that can be refurbished or repurposed. The items you see on this list are either obsolete or non-functional, most likely due to wear and tear over time or general age of device. The **Chromebooks and laptops** on this inventory list have already been “parted out” for repairs over the past several years or cannot be disassembled and reused due to age. Many Chromebooks reached their maximum operating system, which has long since been outdated and will not function with modern software programs and applications. Once that happens we use those Chromebooks for spare parts to minimize repair costs. We have an ample amount of Chromebooks to “part out” in the future, for “loaners” at the school, and we are still maintaining one-to-one status. The **monitors and PCs** are (for the most part) outdated beyond functional use or broken beyond repair. The **iPads** on this list are also non-functional as they are outdated, can no longer receive updates, and will not support app usage or downloads.
