Consider / Approve the 2026-2027 contract with New Energy Technology (NET) for the AEM Console energy management program through June 30, 2027.

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The AEM Console program is utilized as a diagnostic tool for gathering real time energy usage data at every District building. AEM Console gathers, analyzes, and provides load energy data, real-time data management, and support for energy processes such as system scheduling and identifying potential mechanical issues. AEM Console data is analyzed and shared with Plant Managers to make adjustment in usage schedules and to identify areas of concern that staff can then address. The program provides the data, analysis, and formatting to produce reports as tools for decision making and formation of energy usage procedures.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

The annual renewal rate is \$27,000.00, which is equal to the previous year, and is sourced from E=WISE funds.

Service Contract for Kenton County School District School Year 2026-2027

We are pleased to submit this service agreement on behalf of New Energy Technology (NET) to provide comprehensive support to the Kenton County School District (KCSD) in the transition of its Energy Manager database to the AEM Console. Additionally, we will provide support in the daily, weekly, and monthly maintenance of both the monthly utility invoice data and 15-minute Interval Data.

The following table contains the scope of work, deliverables and fees NET will provide to KCSD for its school year starting on July 1st, 2026, and ending on June 30th, 2027:

Deliverables	Annual Fee (ongoing)	Duration
AEM Console License Fee (up to 30 facilities).	\$9,000	12-months
Maintain AEM Console synchronization link with Portfolio Manager.	\$1,800	12-months
Daily maintain the Interval Data database receiving feeds from the Interval Data sources (18-20 meters).	\$16,200	12-months
Total	\$27,000	

All energy and facility data contained in the AEM Console is the sole property of KCSD and will be provided to KCSD upon request in a usable and transferable format.

NET will provide a defined scope of work for a total amount of \$27,000 (not-to-exceed). NET will submit KCSD one invoice for the work being performed in July 2026.

The term of this service contract is for one year and may be extended for another year upon both parties written notice.
