XVI. Landon Spurlock - Ohio County Detention Center

Discussion: Ohio County Jailer, Landon Spurlock gave an update on some things happening at the OC Detention Center. They had just received a \$10,000 KACo grant that allowed them to purchase a new server for the jail management system. In the last year, they were able to increase deputy's pay without increasing their overall budget. They are working with the state to recover any eligible inmate expenses and since 2024 they've been reimbursed around \$22,000, all on medical bills that certain inmates qualify for. They currently in the process of taking bids for their food service, looking to save some money that way. They have also started offering classes to inmates such as a parenting class, a pre-release class along with religious services and addiction counseling.

Executive Summary

This packet presents the finalized loan documents for **Travis J. Johnson, PLLC**, relating to a **\$50,000 loan** from the **Ohio County Economic Development Alliance Revolving Loan Fund (OCEDA RLF)**.

The loan will support the acquisition and transition of a long-standing law practice located at **311 Liberty Street, Hartford, Kentucky**.

Key Loan Terms

Borrower: Travis J. Johnson, PLLC, a Kentucky professional limited liability company

Loan Amount: \$50,000.00

Interest Rate: 4.00% fixed per annum

Loan Term: 60 months

Estimated Monthly Payment: \$920.83

Loan Purpose: Startup and working capital associated with the acquisition and transition of the law practice of Dan Jackson

Economic Impact

The project supports the retention and transition of an established professional business within Ohio County.

The applicant reports that the practice currently employs **four full-time employees and one part-time employee**. The borrower plans to maintain at least **four full-time positions through the second year of operation**.

The practice has historically generated annual gross receipts exceeding **\$440,000**, demonstrating an established operating history and meaningful ongoing economic activity within the community.

Collateral and Security

The loan will be secured by a lien on substantially all business assets of Travis J. Johnson, PLLC, including equipment, furniture, fixtures, inventory, accounts, and other eligible business property.

The final lien priority—whether first-position or subordinated—relative to Cecilian Bank's anticipated **\$500,000 loan** remains to be confirmed and documented.

Consistent with Kentucky legal ethics requirements, the collateral expressly excludes:

- Client trust funds, including IOLTA funds;

- Confidential client files and records;
- Client-owned property; and
- Any property held by the borrower in a fiduciary or representative capacity.

The OCEDA RLF loan will be personally guaranteed by **Travis J. Johnson** and **Dr. Kelsey Johnson**.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ENFORCE LIEN AND IMPENDING SALE OF CERTIFICATE OF DELINQUENCY

Dear Taxpayer:

As a result of nonpayment, this office is required by Chapter 134 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes to notify you that a Certificate of Delinquency was issued and that this Certificate constitutes a lien of record against the above-described real/personal property. This lien must remain on your property until it is paid and the lien cannot be defeated by gift, devise, sale or alienation of the property. Payment of the amount due is a personal obligation of the taxpayer on the assessment date and this certificate bears interest at the legal rate per annum until paid.

At any time after ninety (90) days from the creation of the Certificate of Delinquency, this Certificate may be paid by a **third-party purchaser**, and if so paid, this Certificate will be subject to collection by third-party purchasers who shall impose **substantial additional administrative costs and fees** associated with the collection in addition to the amount due on this Certificate. If this certificate of delinquency is for taxes on real estate then any collection action may include foreclosure.

If you meet the requirements established by our tax collection division and if the terms of the payment plan are agreed to prior to the date of sale of Certificate of Delinquency on October 22, 2026, you may qualify for a payment plan with the county attorney. Box 146, Hartford, KY 42347, (270) 298-4478. **Payment plans may be set up no later than Tuesday, October 20, 2026.**

Only the Ohio County Clerk can calculate the exact and current amount of taxes due and accept payment. **DO NOT SEND PAYMENT TO THIS OFFICE.** Please make arrangements to pay your tax bill to Ohio County Clerk during regular business hours. This notice should be presented to the Clerk at the time you pay the taxes.

OCFC Administrative Code

1. Page 47 -Add - or normal scheduled shift

- Some departments work 10 hours shifts. This will allow them to get a full shift not just 8 hours for holiday. We already do this, just word changing in the admin code.
- 2. Definition: one day – 8 hours or normal scheduled shift.

2. Page 50-Add grandchild, daughter-in-law and son-in-law to three-day bereavement time

- All full-time employees may receive up to three (3) paid funeral bereavement days (a day equals the employees' scheduled work shift) in the event of a death in the employee's immediate family. The following employee family members will be considered as immediate family and qualify employee for bereavement pay:

Spouse, Mother, Father, Child, Grandmother, Grandfather, Mother-in-Law, Father-in-Law, Sister, Brother, Grandchild, Daughter-in-law, Son-in-law

When a full-time employee's extended family member dies, the Fiscal Court allows up to one paid bereavement day (a day equals the employees' scheduled work shift) for the day of the funeral. Extended family members are defined as:

Brother-in-Law, Sister-in-Law, Niece, Nephew, Grandparent of Spouse, Aunt and Uncle of Employee.

3. Page 31-Add any as needed or seasonal employee who goes without working for a period of twelve consecutive weeks or more, will be automatically terminated.

- Part-time is not included and at the supervisor's discretion.
- We are required by KPPA to have a time sheet and report all employees regardless if they have worked or not, to be reported. In January, before processing W2's, I have to delete every, individual check from any employee who has zero income for the year. We have had this happen in the past but currently have one employee who has not worked in a year.

4. Page 35-Add county owned vehicles to #11

- This was an executive order on 7/7/17
- 11. Ohio County wishes to protect the work environment of its employees and the general public; therefore, Ohio County does not permit the use of tobacco products, electronic smoking devices, or any other nicotine delivery system ~~smoking~~ by employees in county buildings other than designated smoking areas. These areas are to be determined by the Judge-Executive. ~~Smoking or tobacco~~ Any nicotine delivery systems, are ~~is~~ not permitted in public hallways, inside offices that are open to the public, the courtroom, county owned vehicles, or any other areas designated by the Judge-Executive. FDA-approved nicotine replacement therapies used for smoking cessation, including nicotine patches, are exempt from this policy.

Interlocal Cooperative Agreement
Among and Between
The Commonwealth of Kentucky Counties of
Daviess, Hancock, Henderson, McLean, Ohio, Union and Webster

THIS INTERLOCAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made among and between the Kentucky Counties of Daviess, Hancock, Henderson, McLean, Ohio, Union and Webster (hereinafter referred to as "Parties") all entities being bodies corporate and politic of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Interlocal Cooperation Act (hereinafter referred to as "State Act"), KRS 65.210 through 65.300 permits the Parties to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate on a basis of mutual advantage and thereby provide services and facilities in a manner and form that will best accord with geographic, economic, population and other factors which influence the needs and development of local communities; and

WHEREAS, the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (hereinafter referred to as the "Federal Act"), enacted by the Congress of the United States, provides for federal United States Department of Labor funds to be granted to the several states for the delivery of services and programs under the Federal Act; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to increase the effectiveness of the area's workforce development system under the Federal Act; and

WHEREAS the purpose of this Agreement is to specify the respective roles of the individual Chief Local Elected Official (CLEO) and Local Elected Officials (LEOs) pursuant to Section 107(c) of the Federal Act, and other related Kentucky Revised Statutes (KRS) and Kentucky Administrative Regulations (KAR) and to comply with the Kentucky Workforce Development Board's Policy Number 15-002 on Interlocal Cooperative Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to terminate and replace the current Interlocal Cooperative Agreement, dated July 1, 2021, with this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and understandings contained herein, the Parties agree to as follows:

1. Execution of Agreement and Effective Date: This Agreement shall become effective upon its approval by the Daviess, Hancock, Henderson, McLean, Ohio, Union and Webster Fiscal Courts and due execution pursuant thereto by each County Judge-Executive (hereinafter referred to collectively as "Local Elected Officials or LEOs"), and upon approval of the Kentucky Commissioner of the Department for Local Government under provisions of the State Act. A

copy of this Agreement, after its full approval shall be duly recorded in the Kentucky Secretary of State's office and with the Kentucky Education and Labor Cabinet (ELC), Department of Workforce Development, as well as the Office of the County Clerks in each county.

2. Agreement Duration: The term of this Agreement shall be from July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2030.
3. Definitions:
 - a. WIOA or Federal Act shall mean the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
 - b. Interlocal Cooperative Agreement shall mean a written agreement that specifies the duties of the CLEO and the individual LEOs that are considered the Cooperative.
 - c. GRWDA shall mean the Green River Workforce Development Area.
 - d. CLEO shall mean the Chief Local Elected Official elected among the Cooperative of Local Elected Officials representing the Local Elected Officials in the GRWDA.
 - e. LEOs shall mean the Local Elected Officials (county judge executives of each of the seven (7) counties, as the highest-ranking government officials), included in the GRWDA.
 - f. ELC shall mean the Education and Labor Cabinet.
 - g. DWD shall mean the Department of Workforce Development.
 - h. GRWDB shall mean the Green River Workforce Development Board as established in WIOA Section 107.
 - i. Governing Board shall mean a board consisting of LEOs that are not administratively attached to the fiscal agent or service provider.
 - j. Supermajority shall mean 65% of the total members of the Governing Board.
 - k. Fiscal Agent shall mean the entity selected to provide fiscal services for the Cooperative provided that such entity agrees to provide such services.
 - l. Grant Subrecipient shall mean the entity selected to provide fiscal services and administrative services for the Cooperative provided that such entity agrees to provide such services.
 - m. RFP shall mean Request for Proposal.
 - n. DWD shall mean the Division of Workforce Investment.
 - o. KWIB shall mean the Kentucky Workforce Investment Board or its successor.
4. Governing Board: A Governing Board of the LEOs for the Green River Workforce Development Area (GRWDA) is hereby established to include the following:
 - a. The Chief Local Elected Official (CLEO) who shall serve as the Chair of the Governing Board, plus the five (5) additional members. The

additional members shall be comprised of the remaining LEOs in the area. The Governing Board shall not exceed seven (7) members, allowing for the remaining County Judge Executive to become a member.

- b. The Governing Board shall within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Agreement establish bylaws and submit a copy to the ELC and DWD.
 - c. The Governing Board shall have a 65% supermajority to take the following actions:
 - i. Selection of the CLEO;
 - ii. Designation of the fiscal agent or local grant subrecipient;
 - iii. Authorization for the CLEO to request the Governor's consent for the local workforce development board to be the direct service provider;
 - iv. Approval of the local workforce development board annual budget; and
 - v. Selection of the one-stop operator.
5. Participating Local Elected Officials: Attached hereto and incorporated herein are the names, representation, and contact information for the CLEO and each LEO in the Green River Workforce Development Area. The information will be updated when necessary and a copy of said updates submitted to the Green River Workforce Development Board and OET within the ELC.
6. Designation of the Chief Local Elected Official:
- a. To ensure there will be no conflict or perceived conflict between the CLEO's duties and the cooperative of LEOs, the Green River Workforce Development Board and grant subrecipient shall adhere to the following selection or appointment process:
 - i. To be elected as the CLEO, the LEO shall receive no less than 65% of the votes of the Governing Board of the GRWDA, present or absent.
 - ii. The CLEO shall not serve as the highest ranking officer on any Board or other entity that governs the fiscal agent or service delivery provider.
 - iii. The CLEO shall not derive any personal benefit or gain, directly or indirectly, by reason of his/her participation as the CLEO of the GRWDA.
 - iv. The CLEO shall disclose to the Governing Board any personal interest, which he/she may have in any matter pending before the organization and shall refrain from participation in any decision on such matter.
 - v. The CLEO and his/her immediate family members shall not be a participant, directly or indirectly, in any arrangement

- agreement, development, or other activity with any vendor, supplier, or other party doing business with the GRWDA which result or may result in a personal benefit. This does not prohibit any eligible CLEO or his or her eligible immediate family member from receiving workforce services.
- vi. The CLEO shall not be a recipient, directly or indirectly, of any salary payments, loans, or gifts of any kind, any free service, discounts, or other fees from or on behalf of any person or organization having transactions with the local workforce development area.
- b. The term of the CLEO shall be two (2) years. After two consecutive terms, the individual must sit out one term before becoming eligible to serve as CLEO again.
 - c. The CLEO shall serve as the signatory, in consultation with and on behalf of, the LEOs related to Federal Act matters.
 - d. In the performance of official duties as CLEO, the CLEO is authorized to make the following decisions in consultation with and on behalf of the LEOs:
 - i. Appoint the members of the GRWDB, ensuring that representation is in accordance with the Federal Act and in accordance with the Kentucky Workforce Investment Board's Policy 15-001;
 - ii. Negotiate the Partnership Agreement in accordance with the Kentucky Workforce Investment Board's Policy Number 15-003;
 - iii. Work with the GRWDB to establish a budget; and
 - iv. Perform all other duties and functions assigned to the LEOs by the Federal Act, or by implementing federal and/or state regulations or policies.
7. Dispute Resolution: Whenever any dispute arises between the Parties under this Agreement, the Parties may invoke Dispute Resolution and agree to seek resolution of such dispute as follows:
- a. The Parties will seek in good faith to resolve any such dispute by arranging a meeting between the Parties or their authorized representatives with authority to resolve the matter within five (5) business days after either Party receives a notice of a dispute. If the Parties are unable to resolve the dispute informally within ten (10) business days, either Party may request the assistance of a mediator.
 - b. If it proves impossible to arrive at a mutually satisfactory solution through mediation within thirty (30) business days of the request for the

mediator, the Parties may refer the dispute to an arbitrator, who will be authorized to make a decision regarding the dispute, and that decision will be final and binding on the Parties.

8. Designation of the Fiscal Agent or Grant Subrecipient: A fiscal agent or grant sub-recipient shall be responsible for the WIOA grant funds. In making such designation, the Governing Board (comprised of the LEOs) shall carry out a competitive procurement process for fiscal agent services or grant subrecipient services, including a Request for Proposal (RFP) that has been reviewed and approved by the DWD and which provides that proposals will be evaluated and ranked based upon criteria including, but not limited to, quality of services, demonstrated experience of service delivery, cost, conflict of interest policies, and history of fiscal integrity.

Such designation shall not relieve the LEOs of the liability for any misuse of grant funds as apportioned in this Agreement.

9. Liability: The local jurisdictions of each LEO shall always remain liable for misuse of funds. In the event of a determination that a misuse of funds has occurred, the following priorities for recouping those funds shall apply:
 - a. First Priority: The Grant Subrecipient shall attempt to recover funds from the contractor, agent of third party causing the liability;
 - b. Second Priority: The Grant Subrecipient shall attempt to recover the funds from an insurance carrier or bond issuer;
 - c. Third Priority: The Grant Subrecipient shall attempt to obtain a waiver of liability or offset liability against current or future grant revenues;
 - d. Fourth Priority: The Grant Subrecipient shall repay the liability from its funds to the extent permitted by law; and
 - e. Fifth Priority: As a last resort and only to the extent required by the Federal Act, the Parties agree to cover unmet liabilities to the state and federal governments. The parties shall share liability to the state and federal governments in proportion to their respective populations using the most recent census data available on the date the negligence or wrongful acts occurred which gave rise to the unmet liability.

10. Local Area Service Delivery Provider:

- a. As authorized in Section 107 (g) (2) of the Federal Act, a Local Workforce Development Board may provide career services described in Section 134(C) (2) through a one-stop delivery system or be designated or certified as a one-stop operator only with the agreement of the CLEO, after

authorization by the Governing Board, and the Governor in accordance with the Kentucky Workforce Investment Board's Policy Number 15-001. To secure the Governor's agreement, the local board must conduct a competitive procurement process facilitated by the DWD for the provision of career services or designation/certification as the one-stop operator, use a process and RFP that has been reviewed and approved by the DWD, be identified as the highest scorer at the completion of the process, and have met performance accountability measures and sustained fiscal integrity.

- b. In cases where the local workforce development board does not seek to provide career services, any one-stop operator (entity or a consortium of entities), Federal Act Section 121(d)(2), shall be designated or certified by the Governing Board through a competitive process in accordance with the Federal Act. The process shall be outlined in a Partnership Agreement between the LEOs and the Green River Workforce Development Board.

11. Communication:

- a. The LEOs shall meet, at the least, annually to discuss the activities within the Green River Workforce Development Area and to complete their responsibilities under the Federal Act. The LEOs also shall meet upon the request of the CLEO, the Governing board, or a majority of the LEOs. The meetings shall be conducted in accordance with the Kentucky Open Meetings Act, KRS 61-805 – 61-850. Minutes of aforementioned meetings shall be distributed to all parties.
- b. At least once a year, the LEOs will conduct a joint meeting to include members of the Green River Workforce Development Board as outlined in the Partnership Agreement.
- c. Any information the LEOs desire to review will be requested from the Green River Workforce Development Board as outlined in the Partnership Agreement.

12. Green River Workforce Development Board Budget Approval:

Pursuant to Section 107(d) (12) of the Federal Act, the Green River Workforce Development Board shall develop a budget for the activities of the board in the local area, consistent with the local plan and the duties of the board, subject to the approval of the CLEO.

- a. The Green River Workforce Development Board shall develop a draft budget and request approval from the CLEO. The CLEO will present the final draft budget for review by the LEOs and approval by the Governing Board.
- b. The final budget shall be presented and approved by the Green River Workforce Development Board. The workforce board chair and the

CLEO, in consultation and on behalf of the LEOs, will then sign the final budget which will be presented to the fiscal agent or grant subrecipient.

13. Green River Workforce Development Board Representation:

- a. The Green River Workforce Development Board's member nomination, selection and confirmation shall comply with the Kentucky Workforce Investment Board's Policy Number 15-001.
- b. The Governor shall, once every two years, certify one local board for each local area in the State. Such certification shall be based on criteria established under the Federal Act, Section 107(b), and for a second or subsequent certification, the extent to which the local board has ensured that workforce development activities carried out in the local area have enabled the local area to meet the corresponding performance accountability measures and achieve sustained fiscal 6 integrity, as defined in section 106(e)(2) of the Federal Act.
- c. Failure of a local board to achieve certification shall result in appointment and certification of a new local board for the local area pursuant to the process described in the Federal Act, Section 107 (c)(2)(C).
- d. The process for determining the initial size of the Green River Workforce Development Board is as follows: the CLEO, in consultation with the LEOs, shall establish the initial size in accordance with Kentucky Workforce Investment Board's Policy Number 15-001 after consideration of fair and equitable representation.
- e. The process for selecting, appointing, removing or reappointing Green River Workforce Development Board members is as follows:
 - i. All Green River Workforce Development Board members shall be appointed in accordance with the criteria established between the Governor and the Kentucky Workforce Investment Board in accordance with the Federal Act and outlined in Kentucky Workforce Investment Board's Policy Number 15-001.
 - ii. Green River Workforce Development Board members who no longer hold the position or status that made them eligible local board members must resign or be removed by the CLEO, in consultation with and on behalf of the LEOs, immediately as a representative of that entity; i.e., no longer work in the private sector, or no longer with an educational institution. For example, an appointee serving because of his/her employment in the private sector must resign or be removed if he/she retires or moves to the public sector.
 - iii. Green River Workforce Development Board Members replacing outgoing members' mid-term, will serve the remainder of the outgoing member's term.
 - iv. The Green River Workforce Development Board vacancies must be filled within a reasonable amount of time of the vacancy

as determined by the Green River Workforce Development Area, but no later than ninety (90) days from occurrence. The CLEO, in consultation with and on behalf of the LEOs, in the Green River Workforce Development Area is authorized to make all reappointments of members. Reappointments must be made within a reasonable time of the term expiration, but no later than ninety (90) days thereafter. Any action taken by the Green River Workforce Development Board, with a vacancy or term expiration beyond the time period described in the Green River Workforce Development Board bylaws or later than the ninety (90) days shall be void unless the Green River Workforce Development Board has an approved waiver from the Office of Employment and Training prior to the Green River Workforce Development Board meeting. Waivers are to be requested in writing to the Director of Workforce and Employment Services, Office of Employment and Training with an explanation of why a vacancy was not filled in the defined timeframe and a description of the process underway to fill the vacancy.

- v. Green River Workforce Development Board members must be removed by the CLEO, in consultation with and on behalf of the LEOs, if any of the following occurs: documented violation of conflict of interest, failure to meet local board member representation requirements defined in the Federal Act and Kentucky Workforce Investment Board's Policy Number 15-001, or documented proof of fraud and/or abuse. Green River Workforce Development Board members will be removed for not meeting attendance guidelines as set forth in the Green River Workforce Development Board's bylaws.
- vi. Green River Workforce Development Board appointments do not require the signature of the LEOs, but rather only the signature of the CLEO. However, this will be done in consultation with and on behalf of the LEOs.

14. Members shall be appointed for staggered terms of three (3) years and shall serve until their successors are appointed by the CLEO, in consultation with and on behalf of the LEOs. The terms shall be based on a calendar year.

15. Selection of a new CLEO: When a new CLEO is selected in accordance with this Agreement, the newly selected CLEO must submit to the Green River Workforce Development Board, DWD, and the ELC, a written statement acknowledging he/she:

- a. Has read, understands and will comply with the current Interlocal Cooperative Agreement; and
- b. Has apprised the ELC and DWD of the change in CLEO designation.

16. Selection of a new LEO: When a new LEO is elected within the Green River Workforce Development Area, the new elected official must submit to the Green River Workforce Development Board a written statement acknowledging that he/she:
 - a. Has read, understands and will comply with the current Interlocal Cooperative Agreement; and
 - b. Reserves the option to request negotiations to amend the Interlocal Cooperative Agreement at any time during the official's tenure as a LEO.
17. Amendment: This Agreement may be amended in writing only subject to the approval of all the parties and recording in accordance with the State Act. A copy of any amendment approved in accordance with the State Act shall be submitted to the Green River Workforce Development Board, DWD, and ELC, after approval by the Department of Local Government in accordance with KRS 65.210-65.300.
18. Signatures: By signing this Agreement, each local elected official certifies his/her signature has been duly authorized by official action of his/her governmental body. The Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which, when combined with all other counterparts, will constitute a completely executed agreement subject to approval by the Department for Local Government.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY
TRANSPORTATION CABINET
DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS
AND THE
COUNTY OF OHIO

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into by and between the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highways, hereinafter referred to as the “Department,” and County of Ohio, 130 East Washington Street, Hartford, KY 42347, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (“LPA”).

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to resurface various roads in Ohio County, which shall hereinafter be referred to as the “Project;”

WHEREAS, the LPA desires to be the lead agency and perform this Project to enhance the safety and reliability of roadway connections for the commuting public;

WHEREAS, the LPA shall refer to the applicable state requirements listed in the Project Development Guide for Local Public Agencies and any future revisions for assistance in complying with this Agreement;

WHEREAS, the LPA has asked the Department for funding assistance for costs incurred during this Project;

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has determined this is a worthwhile Project and has authorized reimbursement to the LPA by the Department in HJR 76 up to \$344,000 in Local Assistance Road Program funding (FD14) for the completion of this Project, and

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WHEREAS, any cost in excess of the reimbursement funding (\$344,000) for this Project will be the responsibility of the LPA.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of these premises and the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The Department agrees to reimburse the LPA up to \$344,000 for completion of work by the LPA, or consultants, contractors, or subcontractors hired by the LPA, under the obligations of this Agreement for resurfacing the following county roads:
 - Harmons Ferry Road (CR 1392) from Milepoint 2.395 extending to Belltown Road for approximately 1.100 miles.
 - Yeaman Road (CR 1018) from the beginning of county maintenance extending to KY 878 for approximately 1.302 miles.
 - McGrady Creek Road (CR 1017) from Olaton Road extending to the end of county maintenance for approximately 1.980 miles.

This Project is designed to enhance the reliability of the highway network and safety for motorists in the area providing safe connections. Any ineligible costs or costs in excess of \$344,000 are the responsibility of the LPA. The LPA further agrees that they will require, in perpetuity, the placement of a culvert or road tile, for any new entrance constructed, that effects the drainage area, surrounding any of the roads listed in this agreement. The manner as to the implementation of this requirement, shall be at the discretion of the LPA.

2. The Department has authorized up to \$344,000 in Local Assistance Road Program funding (FD14) for all eligible expenses for this Project. This funding shall be made available for reimbursement to the LPA for all eligible expenses to the Project. The LPA shall be responsible for all eligible costs above the \$344,000 as well as any costs deemed ineligible for reimbursement from this Project. Any additional funding obligated for the completion of this Project shall be evidenced in writing by both parties with a Supplemental Agreement.

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3. This Agreement is contingent upon the continued availability of appropriated funding. If the funding appropriated for the **Project** becomes unavailable for any reason including: the Kentucky General Assembly's failure to appropriate the funding, by operation of law or as the result of a reduction in funding, further reimbursement of **Project** expenditures may be denied, the **Project** may be cancelled, the timeline extended or the scope amended by the **Department** either in whole or in part without penalty. Denial of further reimbursement, **Project** cancellation, extension or amendment because of an interruption in the appropriated funding is not a default or breach of this Agreement by the **Department** nor may such denial, cancellation, extension or amendment give rise to any claim against the **Department**.
4. The effective date of this Agreement is the date of signature by the Secretary of the Transportation Cabinet. The Term of Eligible Reimbursement under this Agreement shall be three (3) years from the date of its execution unless extended or amended by written Agreement in accordance with the provisions of KRS 45A. Any and all funding obligated for any phase of this **Project** shall be available to reimburse the **LPA** for eligible work activities completed and costs incurred prior to expiration.
5. The **LPA** shall follow state specifications for each necessary phase of this **Project**. The **LPA** shall adhere to all state regulations, including KRS 45A, KRS 176, KRS 177, and all terms of this Agreement for activities related to this **Project** as lead agency. The **LPA** will obtain any required permits, licenses or easements required to initiate, perform, and complete work and provide documentation to the **Department's** District 2 Office in Madisonville. In addition, the **LPA** is responsible to meet all other requirements and adhere to all regulations necessary to qualify for the receipt of these state funds. Concurrence must be obtained by the **LPA** through the **Department's** District 2 Chief District Engineer in Madisonville prior to the awarding of any contract for work or materials to be used on this **Project**.
6. Should the **Project** require any design services, the **LPA** agrees to use only licensed consultants who are pre-qualified to do work for the **Department** or to use a licensed Professional Engineer registered in the Commonwealth of Kentucky that demonstrates

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sufficient experience and knowledge in the type of work and receives the approval of the Department's District 2 Chief District Engineer in Madisonville. The LPA shall be responsible for all Project design activities, which may be completed either by the LPA's staff or a consultant that is to be selected based on qualifications. All design work to be contracted must comply with all legal advertisement and selection requirements including, but not limited to, the Model Procurement Code provisions of KRS 45A and KRS 424. The LPA shall submit and obtain concurrences to the Department's District 2 Chief District Engineer in Madisonville final design plans, specifications, and a total estimate prior to any construction. When applicable, the LPA must obtain any necessary permits or easements to allow for work to be accomplished on this Project and adhere to the Uniform Relocation Assistance (URA) and Real Property Acquisitions Policies Act.

7. Should the Project require the acquisition of any interest in real property by the LPA, the LPA shall ensure that all real property acquisition, relocation assistance, and property management are completed in a fair, equitable and approved manner consistent with all state laws and regulations governing the acquisition of real property for public use using highway funding. In all real property acquisitions, concurrence must be obtained through the Department's Division of Right of Way and Utilities and shall be subject to review and approval by the Department.
8. The LPA must obtain encroachment permits to allow for work to be accomplished on state owned right-of-way from the Department's District 2 Office in Madisonville. The LPA acknowledges that the Department will require the placement of a restrictive easement approved by and in favor of the Department in the chain of title of any real property acquired or improved pursuant to the Project. If the owner of any real property acquired or improved pursuant to the Project is not the Department or the LPA, the owner shall sign and be made a party to this Agreement and the owner hereby acknowledges, covenants and consents to the placement of a restrictive easement for perpetual maintenance of the property acquired or improved pursuant to the Project in the chain of title in favor of the Department prior to final reimbursement by the Department.

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9. The LPA shall either adopt in writing the Department's written Policies and Procedures for Right of Way Acquisition and Relocation Assistance or present its own written Policies and Procedures for approval by the Department's Division of Right of Way and Utilities. The LPA shall conduct all appraisals and appraisal reviews using personnel meeting the Department's minimum qualifications and listed on the Department's pre-qualified appraiser and reviewer list. If the LPA chooses to use an acquisition consultant on all or any portion of the Project, the selection of the consultant shall be in accordance with the Department's Division of Right of Way Guidance Manual. All appraisals must be reviewed and approved by the Department's Central Office review appraisers, failure to do so will result in the Project being ineligible for funding reimbursement. The LPA shall provide property management in accordance with approved procedures and be responsible for the abatement of any asbestos containing materials and removal of contaminated soils pursuant to applicable state laws and regulations. The LPA shall provide the Department necessary assurance that all real property has been acquired and all displaced individuals, businesses, non-profit organizations and farms have been offered relocation assistance according to applicable state laws and regulations. The LPA shall provide the Department necessary documentation for review and approval at various stages of the acquisition process, as described in the Department's Right of Way Guidance Manual.
10. When conducting a utility relocation, KRS 177.035 and KRS 179.265 determine the necessity of payment for utility companies. Identification of utility or railroad facilities in conflict with the Project, the execution of a remedy for said conflict and oversight of the execution, and all work related to the Project shall be done in accordance with the Cabinet's Standards, Specifications, Standard Drawings, and Utilities and Rails Manual. Utility relocations shall be designed by the utility company and shown on the Project's survey and general plan sheets. The impacted utility company, with its regular construction or maintenance personnel, and/or with an approved contractor or subcontractor, will furnish all engineering, administration, labor, and materials to make and complete all necessary adjustments of its facilities to accommodate the Project. Correspondence pertaining to utility or railroad coordination must

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be provided to both contracted parties. If a conflict of interest arises between the obligated party and a utility company, the unobligated party shall intercede to provide the utility coordination. The completed relocation shall be inspected to document the proper installation of the facilities. Upon full execution of the utility relocation for the Project, three (3) sets of as-built plans for each utility company that completes facility relocation on the project prior to the construction letting, a utility impact note defining the utilities identified in the Project, relocations that have been performed, incomplete relocations, and completion schedules for the incomplete work must be provided.

11. State construction criteria for the type of work shall be followed, including but not limited to the Department's Highway Design Manual, the Department's Standard Drawings, the Department's Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, the Department's Drainage Manual, the Department's Structural Design Manual, the American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials' (AASHTO) "Policy on Geometric Design of Highways and Streets," and the FHWA Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). All work performed shall be in accordance with the Department's Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, current edition, and as provided in Subsection 105.01 of said Specifications. All materials furnished shall be in accordance with Subsection 106 of said Specifications to include all Department List of Approved Materials. These standards, specifications, and criteria are incorporated in this Agreement by this reference.
12. The LPA agrees to use only licensed contractors and subcontractors who are pre-qualified to do work for the Department for any necessary construction services. The LPA shall be responsible for all Project construction activities, which may be completed either by the LPA's staff or through the advertisement, opening of bids, selection, and contracting for contractor services in accordance with the Model Procurement Code provisions of KRS 45A and KRS 424. Specific requirements defined within KRS 45A require that the award be made to the lowest responsive bidder meeting the criteria of responsibility established by the Department. The contractor affirms that it is properly authorized under the laws of the

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Commonwealth of Kentucky to conduct business in this state and will remain in good standing to do business in the Commonwealth of Kentucky for the duration of any contract awarded. The contractor shall maintain certification of authority to conduct business in the Commonwealth of Kentucky during the term of this contract. Such registration is obtained from the Secretary of State, who will also provide the certification thereof. The LPA must receive Department approval for all change orders and shall have approval of the appropriate governing authority, but shall not increase the funding obligated to the LPA as a result of this Agreement.

13. The contractor represents that, pursuant to KRS 45A.485, they and any subcontractor performing work under the contract will be in continuous compliance with the KRS chapters listed below and have revealed to the Commonwealth any violation determinations within the previous five (5) years:

- KRS Chapter 136 (CORPORATION AND UTILITY TAXES)
- KRS Chapter 139 (SALES AND USE TAXES)
- KRS Chapter 141 (INCOME TAXES)
- KRS Chapter 337 (WAGES AND HOURS)
- KRS Chapter 338 (OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH OF EMPLOYEES)
- KRS Chapter 341 (UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION)
- KRS Chapter 342 (WORKERS COMPENSATION)

The contractor represents that, pursuant to KRS 45A.607, they are not currently engaged in, and will not for the duration of the contract engage in, the boycott of a person or an entity based in or doing business with a jurisdiction with which Kentucky can enjoy open trade. Note: The term Boycott does not include actions taken for bona fide business or economic reasons, or actions specifically required by federal or state law.

The contractor represents that they, and any subcontractor performing work under the contract, have not violated the agency restrictions contained in KRS 11A.236 during the previous ten

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(10) years, and pledges to abide by the restrictions set forth in such statute for the duration of the contract awarded.

The contractor further represents that, pursuant to KRS 45A.328, they have not procured an original, subsequent, or similar contract while employing an executive agency lobbyist who was convicted of a crime related to the original, subsequent, or similar contract within five (5) years of the conviction of the lobbyist.

14. The Equal Employment Opportunity Act of 1978 (the "Act"), KRS 45.560 to 45.640, applies to all State government contracts or subcontracts in an amount exceeding \$500,000. The contractor shall comply with all terms and conditions of the Act.

During the performance of this contract, the Contractor agrees as follows:

- (a) The Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, age forty (40) and over, disability, veteran status, or national origin or.
- (b) The Contractor shall take affirmative action in regard to employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination rates of pay or other forms of compensation, and selection for training, so as to ensure that applicants are employed and that employees are treated during employment without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, age forty (40) and over, disability, veteran status, and national origin. Such action shall include, but not be limited to the following:
- (c) The Contractor shall state in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the Contractor that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age forty (40) and over, disability, veteran status, or national origin.
- (d) The Contractor shall post notices in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, setting forth the provisions of this non-discrimination clause.

The Contractor shall send a notice to each labor union or representative of workers with which he/she has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding advising the

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said labor union or workers' representative of the Contractor's commitments under this nondiscrimination clause.

The Contractor's noncompliance with the nondiscrimination clauses of this contract shall constitute a material breach of the contract.

Each Contractor shall, for the length of the contract or at the point at which the contract is covered by this Act and until its conclusion, furnish such information as required by the Act and any rules, regulations and orders issued pursuant thereto and permit access to all books and records pertaining to his employment practices and work sites by the contracting agency and the Cabinet to ascertain compliance with the Act.

This section applies to agreements disbursing federal funds, in whole or part, only when the terms for receiving those funds mandate its inclusion.

15. The LPA shall be responsible for all aspects of administration, measuring, testing, and inspections to ensure the materials and work meets the Department's specifications of the construction contract. This includes providing daily, on-site inspection of the contractor's work activities and processing all of the paperwork associated with the construction contract, including any change orders. The Department shall have access to the Project area and may conduct field reviews of the Project at any time. These field reviews are intended to verify status of the Project, performance of the contractor, adequacy of the LPA oversight, conformance with all laws, regulations, and policies and provide assistance to the LPA as may be necessary.
16. The LPA may submit to the Department's District 2 Office in Madisonville current billings reflecting the actual cost of work incurred during any given work period, which will be paid within a reasonable time after receipt by the Department; however, in no event is the LPA to submit billings for work performed for less than a thirty (30) day period. All charges to the Project shall be supported by properly executed invoices, contracts, or vouchers evidencing in proper detail the nature and propriety of the charge. The Department may require additional documentation at their discretion.

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17. The LPA is responsible for ensuring that all Project construction activities have been completed and are responsible for providing all of the necessary paperwork as required by the construction contract. The LPA will conduct a field inspection to verify completion of the work in conformance with the Agreement. This documentation must be provided to the Department's District 2 Chief District Engineer in Madisonville prior to final payment of the Project. When both the LPA and the Department accept the field work as complete, the LPA's project manager shall certify the Project was constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications and that all funding authorized on this Project has been used to reimburse for materials, equipment, or labor as intended and at the location agreed herein by both parties. Upon receipt of the Department's Final Acceptance Report, the LPA will issue the final payment to the contractor with an official Release of Contractor form for signature. Within 30 days, the LPA shall provide the Department with a copy of the official Release of Contractor form, as well as proof of payment, which includes cancelled checks.
18. The LPA is responsible for ensuring that vendors shall be paid, upon the submission of proper invoices to the receiving agency at the prices stipulated for the supplies delivered and accepted, or services rendered. Unless otherwise specified, payment will not be made for partial deliveries accepted. Payments will be made within thirty (30) working days after receipt of goods or a vendor's invoice in accordance with KRS 45.453 and KRS 45.454.
19. This Agreement and the maintenance responsibilities herein shall survive in perpetuity the cancellation or termination of all or any portion of the Project, and shall survive the completion of and acceptance of the Project. To protect the public interest and maintain the original intent, the LPA agrees to maintain in an acceptable condition all facilities improved by the Project to the condition existing at the time of the Final Acceptance Report in perpetuity. In the event that the Project improvements are not maintained as a public facility, the LPA shall reimburse the Department for all costs incurred and for all funding expended pursuant to the Project, including any applicable interest.

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20. The LPA shall maintain for a period of three (3) years all records of materials, equipment, and labor costs involved in the performance of work of said Project. In order to obtain reimbursement from the Department for constructing said Project, the LPA shall submit to the Department's District 2 Office in Madisonville documented invoices of materials, equipment, and labor used on the Project, including certification that the work was accomplished on a publicly maintained facility.
21. No member, officer, or employee of the Department or the LPA during his tenure or for one (1) year thereafter shall have any financial interest, direct or indirect, in this Agreement or the proceeds thereof as identified in KRS 45A.340. The Department and the LPA shall comply with the requirements of the Executive Branch Code of Ethics KRS Chapter 11A. The LPA warrants that no person, elected official, selling agency or other organization has been employed or retained to solicit or secure this Agreement upon an agreement or understanding for a commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee. No member, officer, or employee of the Department or LPA shall collude or lobby on behalf of this Project without penalty, including but not limited to suspension or debarment.
22. To the extent permitted by law, the LPA shall indemnify and hold harmless the Department and all of its officers, agents, and employees from all suits, actions, or claims of any character arising from any injuries, payments or damages received or claimed by any person, persons, or property resulting from implementation of any phase of the Project or occurring on or near the Project site.
23. Either party may cancel the contract at any time for cause or may cancel without cause on 30 days written notice.
 - a. The Department reserves the right to cancel all reimbursements under this Agreement at any time deemed to be in the best interest of the Department by giving thirty (30) days written notice of such cancellation to the LPA. If reimbursement under this Agreement is canceled under this section by reason other than violation of this Agreement or any applicable law by the LPA, its agents, employees and contractors, the Department shall reimburse the LPA

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according to the terms hereof for all expenses incurred under this Agreement to the date of such cancellation of reimbursement.

b. The LPA may seek to cancel its obligations under this Agreement at any time deemed to be in the best interest of the LPA by giving thirty (30) days written notice of such request to the Department. If the Department agrees to allow the LPA to cancel the Project or cancel its obligations under this Agreement, the LPA shall reimburse the Department for all funding reimbursements made under this Agreement.

c. Any dispute concerning a question of fact in connection with the work not disposed of by Agreement between the LPA and the Department shall be referred to the Secretary of the Transportation Cabinet of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, or his duly authorized representative, whose decision shall be final. Any proposed change or extension to this Agreement shall be at the mutual consent of the LPA and the Department and be evidenced in writing.

24. The Kentucky General Assembly may allow for a reduction in a contract worker hours in conjunction with a budget balancing measure for some professional and non-professional service contracts. If under such authority the agency is required by Executive Order or otherwise to reduce contract hours, the contract will be reduced by the amount specified in that document.

25. The Department certifies that it is in compliance with the provisions of KRS 45A.695, "Access to contractor's books, documents, papers, records, or other evidence directly pertinent to the contract." The LPA hereby acknowledges it is responsible to inform any entity it intends to hire or use as a contractor, as defined in KRS 45A.030(9), that the contracting agency, the Finance and Administration Cabinet, the Auditor of Public Accounts, and the Legislative Research Commission, or their duly authorized representatives, shall have access to any books, documents, papers, records, or other evidence, which are directly pertinent to this contract for the purpose of financial audit or program review. Records and other prequalification information confidentially disclosed as part of the bid process shall not be deemed as directly pertinent to the contract and shall be exempt from disclosure as provided in KRS 61.878(1)(c).

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The contractor also recognizes that any books, documents, papers, records, or other evidence, received during a financial audit or program review shall be subject to the Kentucky Open Records Act, KRS 61.870 to 61.884.

26. KRS 45A.485 requires the LPA to certify that all contractors shall reveal to the Department, any final determination of a violation by the contractor within the previous five (5) year period of the provisions of KRS chapters 136, 139, 141, 337, 338, 341, and 342. These statutes relate to the state sales and use tax, corporate and utility tax, income tax, wages and hours laws, occupational safety and health laws, unemployment insurance laws, and workers compensation insurance laws, respectively.

The LPA shall certify that all contractors agree to be in continuous compliance with the provisions of those statutes which apply to the contractor's operations. Failure to reveal a final determination or failure to comply with the above statutes for the duration of the contract shall be grounds for the LPA's cancellation of the contract and the contractor's disqualification from eligibility for future state contracts for a period of two (2) years.

To comply with KRS 45A.485, the Contractor and all subcontractors performing work under this contract shall report any such final determination(s) of any violation(s) within the previous five (5) years to the Commonwealth by providing a list of the following information regarding any violation(s): (1) specific KRS violated, (2) date of any final determination of a violation, and (3) state agency which issued the final determination.

A list of any disclosures made prior to award of a contract shall be attached to the contract.

The Contractor affirms that it has not violated any of the provisions of the above statutes within the previous five (5) year period, aside from violations explicitly disclosed and attached to this contract. Contractor further affirms that it will (1) communicate the above KRS 45A.485 disclosure requirements to any subcontractors and (2) disclose any subcontractor violations it becomes aware of to the Commonwealth.

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27. It is understood and agreed by these parties that if any part of this contract is held by the courts to be illegal or in conflict with any law of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, the validity of the remaining portions or provisions shall not be affected, and the rights and obligations of the parties shall be construed and enforced as if the contract did not contain the particular part, term, or provision held to be invalid.
28. The **LPA** will pass a resolution authorizing the Judge Executive to sign this Agreement on behalf of the **LPA**. An acceptable Resolution shall contain the project name, description, amount of funds being provided and an acknowledgement that the **LPA** agrees to ratify and adopt all statements, representations, warranties, covenants, and agreements contained in the Agreement. Furthermore, by accepting the funds the **LPA** agrees to all terms and conditions stated in the Agreement. A copy of that resolution shall be attached to and made a part of this Agreement.

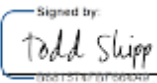
