Adult Meal Pricing

To ensure that federal child nutrition funds do not subsidize adult meals, participants of the National School Lunch Program must price adult meals in accordance with FNS 782-5 Revision 1. The charge for an adult meal should be at least the amount of reimbursement received plus the per meal value of donated foods. School districts are notified annually by KDE of new rates.

Breakfast $\$2.54 + .51 + .32 = \3.40

Lunch $\$4.76 + .11 + .32 = \5.20
