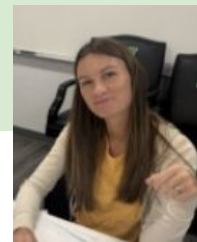
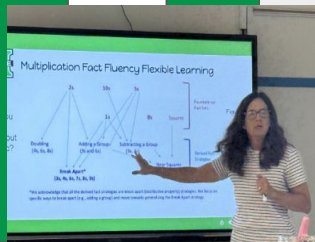
Post-conference feedback highlighted exceptional engagement, peer collaboration, and immediate classroom applicability.
