

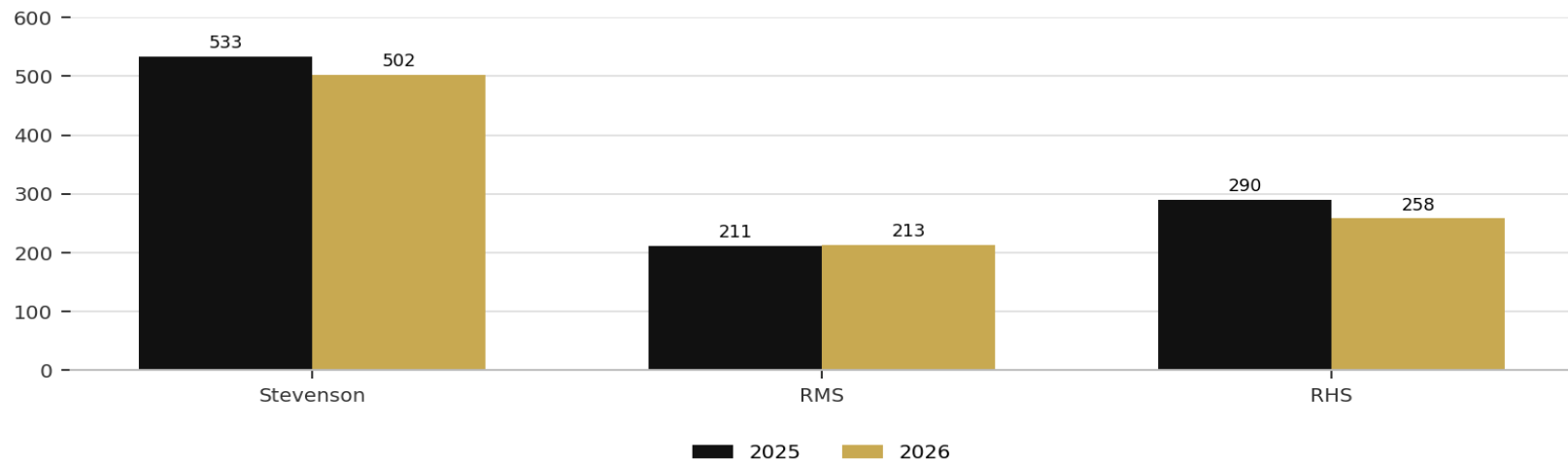

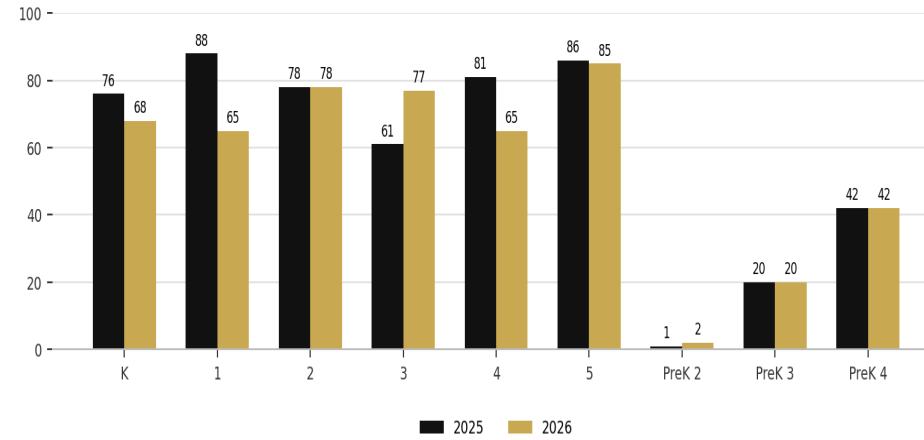

Notes

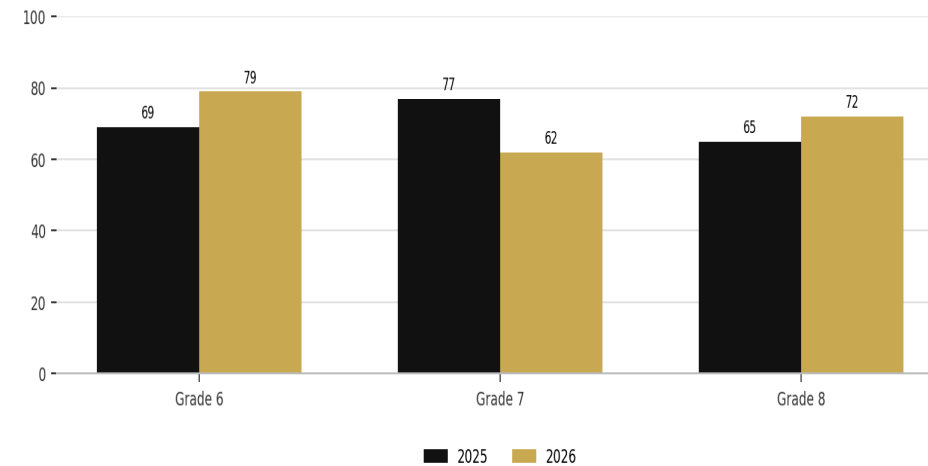
- Total enrollment decreased from 533 to 502 (-31, -5.8%).
- K-5 decreased from 470 to 438 (-32, -6.8%), while preschool increased from 63 to 64 (+1).
- The largest decreases were Grade 1 (-23), Grade 4 (-16), and Kindergarten (-8).
- Grade 3 increased by 16 students; Grade 2 was unchanged.

Preschool codes: 97 = age 2, 98 = age 3, and 99 = age 4.

Russellville Middle School

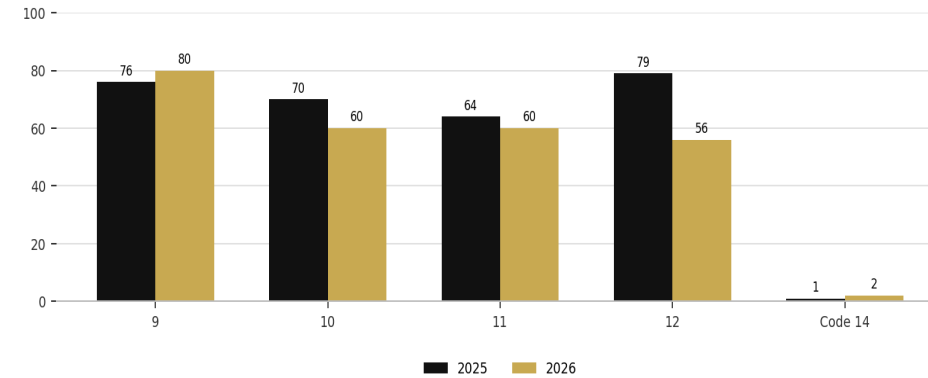
Notes

- Enrollment increased slightly from 211 to 213 (+2, +0.9%).
- Grade 6 increased by 10 and Grade 8 increased by 7.
- Grade 7 decreased by 15, offsetting most of the gains in Grades 6 and 8.
- RMS was the only one of the three schools with a net enrollment increase.

Russellville High School

Grades 9-12 plus grade code 14 as reported

Grade 12	79	56	-23	-29.1%

Notes

- Enrollment decreased from 290 to 258 (-32, -11.0%).
- Grade 12 decreased by 23 students and accounted for most of the schoolwide decline.
- Grade 10 decreased by 10 and Grade 11 decreased by 4, while Grade 9 increased by 4.
