Subject: Reimbursement Rate Increase

Adult Meal Price Increase

The USDA requires all nonprogram meals that are sold to adults be priced in accordance with [FNS Instruction 782-5 Revision 1](#). Any meal sold to an adult must be priced to meet the minimum required price to ensure that no federal child nutrition funds are subsidizing adult meals. This is effective from the beginning of the school year and applies to all adult meals.
