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Consent Agenda Item (Action Item): Consider approval of an out-of-state trip for Gifted and Talented high school students. The proposed date will be in June 2027.

Proposed trip destinations include one of these destinations: Chicago, Illinois; New York City, NY; Niagara Falls, California; and Williamsburg, VA. (We are checking on prices.) The goal is to offer our students the best affordable, yet outstanding educational experience.

Applicable State or Regulations:

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact: Cost per student will vary. The trip will include a four-day and 3-night trip, all-inclusive.

History/Background: The educational travel destination to Washington, DC, was a wonderful opportunity for the students this past June. As the Gifted and Talented Coordinator, it is a matter of urgency to get communication out to parents and plan a meeting as soon as our travel destination can be selected. This is of great importance. I need to meet with parents so they can begin paying toward the selected destination. I am in communication with tour companies and waiting for the cost at this time. We had a proposal for Boston, but this was not affordable for most of our student population.

Recommended Action: Approve the out-of-state trip for Gifted and Talented high school students in June. As the coordinator, I am requesting approval to inform parents of the Gifted and Talented program that we are going on an out-of-state trip. I will follow up at the next board meeting with an agenda that has a finalized itinerary.
