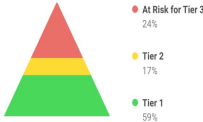

Overall Placement



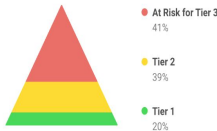
Placement By Domain



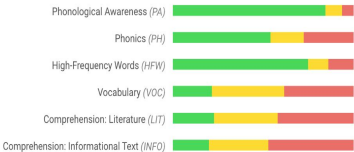

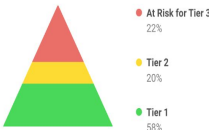


Placement By Domain



## Math Beginning of Year View

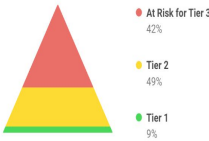
Overall Placement

## Continuous Improvement

Weekly PLCs are individualized to meet the needs of content-area teachers. The primary focus is unit internalization using the HQIR to develop a deep understanding of upcoming lessons and to review and/or practice key instructional moves and routines. During this process, teachers have the opportunity to anticipate student needs, determine appropriate supports and scaffolds for upcoming lessons, and identify how individual lessons connect to the unit as a whole. Teachers also examine key portions of each lesson to ensure that instructional protocols and routines have been explicitly taught and are being implemented effectively. This collaborative process allows teachers to enter each lesson prepared to meet student needs while maintaining fidelity to the HQIR.

The instructional team has been conducting walkthroughs using the IPG tool and providing immediate feedback to teachers.

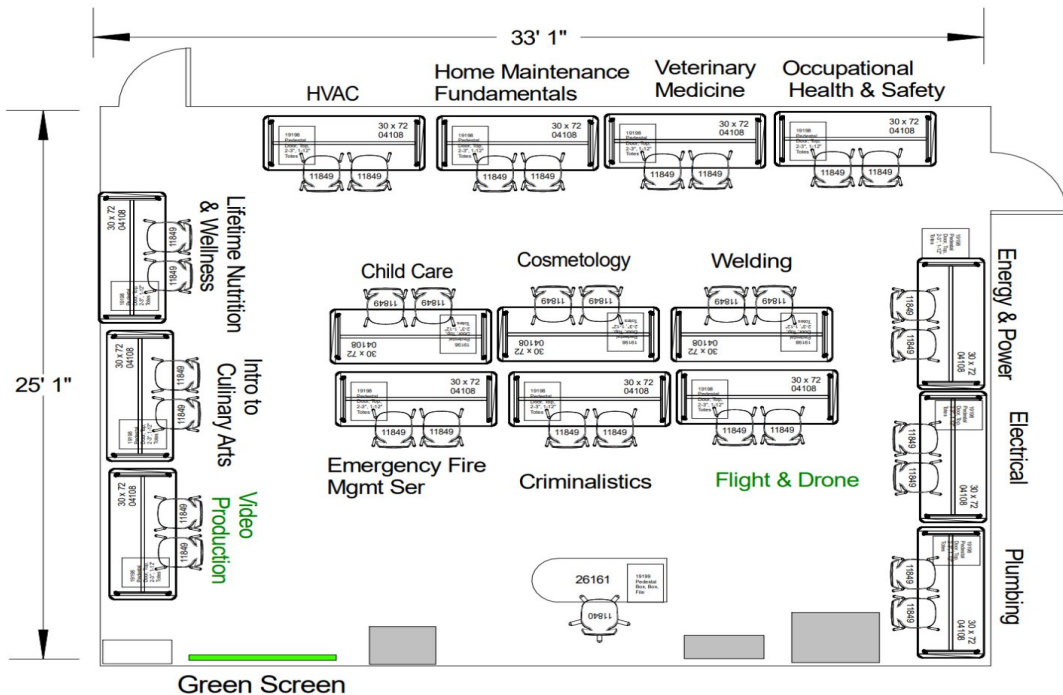

## *Menifee County High School Continuous Improvement*

- PLC Focus: PLCs are focused on strengthening intellectual preparation through completion of unit internalization and intentional HQIR annotation to ensure teachers are prepared to deliver grade-appropriate, rigorous instruction. Teachers are working through the process and began annotating their HQIR.
- Instructional Walkthroughs: The CIA Team is conducting instructional walkthroughs using the Instructional Practice Guide (IPG) and KDE-aligned documents to monitor instructional practices and provide meaningful feedback.
- Feedback & Support: Walkthrough feedback is being provided to staff to identify strengths, opportunities for growth, and next steps that support continuous improvement in classroom instruction. Teachers will also receive feedback on their pacing guides.
- College & Career Readiness: Dual credit classes have begun through both the University of Kentucky (UK) and MCTC.
- The Advisory Council and Turn Around team continue to monitor our improvement priorities.

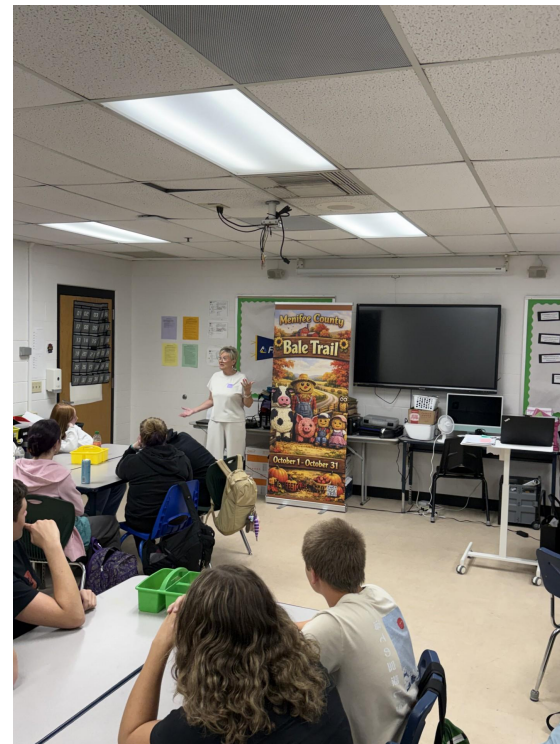
## **FBLA: Future Friday**
