Academic Information

- Fall MAP testing has wrapped up. Overall, we are pleased with where we are starting. However, we know this is a starting point and the work most definitely continues.
 - HS Math - 38.9% of the students starting in the 61st - 99th (Green/Blue) percentile range on the achievement percentile.
 - HS Reading - 51.2% of the students starting in the 61st - 99th (Green/Blue) percentile range on the achievement percentile.
 - MS Math - 41.8% of the students starting in the 61st - 99th (Green/Blue) percentile range on the achievement percentile.
 - MS Reading - 47.6% of the students starting in the 61st - 99th (Green/Blue) percentile range on the achievement percentile.
- Based on our Fall MAP data, our intervention groups will be starting the week of September 14th.
