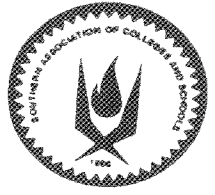

- **How will the Section 7 money be used to decrease the % of novice and apprentice level students in school?**

Our plan is to take the \$15,306 dollars and hire two part- time interventionists. They will work for approximately 2.5 hours per day with students in both math and reading who have been identified as novice and apprentice from the spring MAP testing. Kindergarten will screen students during the first two weeks of school so that kindergarten students needing this service will be able to begin interventions immediately.

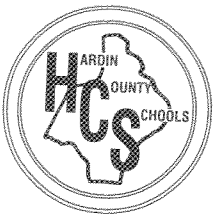

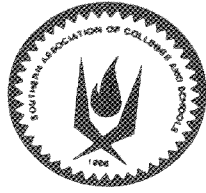
#3 ...analyze test scores, MAP, Guides (common assessment) and other performance data to identify curriculum gaps that need to be addressed within sub populations of NCLB.
