## COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY OHIO COUNTY FISCAL COURT ORDINANCE NO: 2011-8

## AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSITION OF FEES BY AND PAYMENT OF COSTS OF THE OFFICES OF SHERIFF AND COUNTY CLERK WITHIN OHIO, KENTUCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Ohio County Fiscal Court of Ohio County, Kentucky;

- SECTION I: Upon the adoption of this Ordinance, County Ordinance 94-4 adopted on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1993 shall be repealed in its entirety.
- SECTION II: Effective upon the adoption of this Ordinance, all net income and net fees from the offices of Sheriff and County Clerk, Ohio County, Kentucky, shall be paid over to the County Treasurer, such payment to be on a monthly basis and not later than the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month for the net income and net fees collected in the preceding month.
- SECTION III: "NET INCOME" and "NET FEES" shall mean all income and all fees collected less only applicable refunds to customers.
- SECTION IV: The expenses of and the expenditures by the Offices of Sheriff and County Clerk, Ohio County, Kentucky shall be pre-approved and paid by the County Treasurer in accordance with the system adopted by the Ohio County Fiscal Court; provided, however, the Sheriff and County Clerk shall certify to the Treasurer for payment each pay period the names and hours of each employee of their respective offices who worked during such pay period and the Treasurer shall pay such payrolls without the necessity of prior court approval.

SECTION V: a) The Sheriff and the County Clerk shall draw no checks upon the Fee Accounts other than the check to pay over the net income and net fees of the Fee Accounts to the County Treasurer except as provided for in Section V (b). b) The Sheriff and the Countre clerk mean each from their sum

b) The Sheriff and the County clerk may each, from their own accounts, expend in each fiscal year the sum of \$5,000.00 for payment of such things as maintenance, conference attendance, and continuing education classes by the Sheriff, the County Clerk,

and their employees and any other expenses relating to the operation of their offices.

SECTION VI: The Sheriff and the County Clerk shall be compensated at the maximum rate permitted by law.

SECTION VII: The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any provisions or part thereof shall be held invalid or unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such invalidity, unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not or impair the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION VIII: This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage.
