Through her leadership as a tennis and basketball coach, she has built lifelong relationships with students — helping them discover their strengths, overcome challenges, and believe in themselves. Her athletes are not only taught the fundamentals of the game but also the value of teamwork, perseverance, and sportsmanship. Her calm, steady presence brings out the best in students on and off the court. While Marti is humble in nature and would never seek recognition for herself, the impact she has made is widely known and appreciated by the NOMS community.
