1. TVI MOA

Approval of this Memorandum of Agreement will ensure that Trigg County Public Schools has access to qualified in-person Teacher of the Visually Impaired (TVI) services for students requiring specialized vision instruction and consultation during the 20262027 school year. This agreement provides direct instructional services, consultation, IEP participation, evaluations, and staff and family support as required by students' Individualized Education Programs (IEPs). Securing these services supports the district's compliance with federal and state special education requirements while ensuring students receive the specialized instruction necessary to access their educational programs. This agreement addresses a critical staffing need by providing highly specialized services that are not available through district personnel.

G. Approve Emergency Certification

KRS 161.100 allows the Educational Professional Standards Board to issue Emergency Certification to an applicant when a district cannot secure a qualified applicant for a certified teaching position.
