Arvin gave the board a draft of his evaluation and Mrs. Burgett would like the board members to have it completed by the end of June.

Mrs. Dunavent reported that graduation went great. Mrs. Dunavent shared the golf team has been invited to the Midwest Golf Showcase June 18th and 19th and asked the board if they would be interested in paying the entry fee and maybe the hotel fees for the team, since they will not have time to fundraiser for this event. Mr. Davis shared he received the final email for our recent OEA investigations. When hiring Mr. Arvin, they found no wrongdoing in the superintendent search committee. They found no wrongdoing with what the board had done and explained why no laws were violated in the way it was done and the board can add and remove items to the agenda in a regular meeting and prior to the meeting with three of the five votes. Everyone was cleared on that. There were two other investigations. One reported items discussed in closed session were referenced but no specifics are mentioned, OEA found no wrongdoing. 6. STAFF REPORT

A. Virtual Students Update

Mrs. Lewis reported on the virtual program. She had 61 students this year. The program will take some students from grades 6 to 12 that have extenuating circumstances. We will take out of district applications and home school students. She host two open houses each year for our home school partners and have conversations about how we can partner with them and get them into the school. Last year she brought in 11 new students. This year she brought in 10 new students. Over the last two years we have added 21 new students.

The Virtual Academy had 100% graduation rate and 100% post secondary readiness. She stated, "We worked very hard for that and the kids worked very hard for that. So, they were very excited." We do have one, however, that was given a letter to attend summer school that student will be coming back in person next year that was not successful and that was not the best placement for that student. She has a gambit of students. Several students who were taking dual credit college classes. Some students that had some legal things going on. Four students that have children. These are male and female students pregnant or had a child during the school year.

Lots of good things going on in the virtual academy. Mrs. Lewis had a parent email Mr. Arvin the benefits of the program for her child and Mr. Arvin shared that with the board. Another parent spoke to the board about how much the program has helped her children. Mr. Davis thanked Mrs. Lewis what she is doing for the program and the work she has put in. Mrs. Dunavent and Mrs. Burgett also gave kudos and thanks to Mrs. Lewis

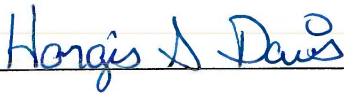
