VI. Work Sessions

A. Update on JCPS Police Department

Dr. Pollio introduced this item, and the Security and Investigations leadership team presented the update. Each Board member had an opportunity to comment and ask questions.

Mrs. Duncan questioned response time and wanted to ensure staff would be well-equipped with adequate resources. She inquired about the training's workload and asked if the upcoming school year's opening procedures would deviate from previous years.

Dr. Kolb inquired about new applications for officers and how those numbers compare to previous years. He inquired about the status of collaboration with local police departments and emphasized the need for a clear command structure.

Mr. Craig requested data on the number of firearms discovered on school grounds during the 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years.

Ms. McIntosh inquired about any instances where officers encountered difficulties accessing school buildings. She requested data on officer retention rates for the past school year and sought clarification on communication protocols and procedures with external emergency services.

B. Update on Transportation/First Day of School

Dr. Pollio introduced this item. Rob Fulk, chief operations officer; Eddie Muns, chief financial officer; and Marcus Dobbs, executive administrator of transportation; presented the update. Each Board member had an opportunity to comment and ask questions.

Mrs. Duncan voiced concern about the implementation of a third start time, questioning its necessity. She inquired about anticipated traffic patterns and sought clarification on the stipend payment schedule for families. Additionally, she questioned the effectiveness of regionalizing bus routes and requested confirmation that school staff would receive compensation for any extended work hours.

Ms. McIntosh reported receiving feedback indicating that the online transportation forms currently lack the ability to input information for two households sharing custody of a student. She verified that the Bus Finder system is no longer operational and inquired about the plan to prevent bus overcrowding if routes are reinstated at certain schools.

Dr. Kolb requested a comparison of the current number of bus drivers to the number at the start of the previous school year. He inquired if the potential reinstatement of certain bus routes was contingent solely on the utilization of TARC drivers.

Ms. Logan Strange inquired about the criteria for determining bus stop locations when TARC drivers are employed. She expressed concern regarding insufficient parking spaces for high school students and reported receiving complaints from families with multiple children assigned to different schools.

Mr. Craig sought confirmation that the Transportation team possesses the necessary resources to ensure a successful school opening. He inquired about the need for a special meeting to authorize the reinstatement of bus routes to specific schools.
