1. Opening Business

Motion Passed: Approve agenda as presented passed with a motion by Jessica Conley and a second by Jessica Humbert and consensus of the council.

Senora Bonfield won the Gold Star Teacher of the Year by a landslide and we're grateful for all of the support shown by our community.

2. Allocations

Creating an ad hoc committee to work with the teachers where there are scheduling issues (e.g. Spanish).

Last year we were allocated 50 positions, two of which were never filled. This year we were allocated 48 positions. We currently have 48 filled positions, so we aren't losing any positions. Special Education teacher positions are not part of that number - there are no changes to the number of SPED teachers.

Phil requested a spreadsheet to better organize the information and asked about the number of students enrolled at each grade level. Mr. Barwell shared that there are a total of 367 incoming 6 grade students, 390 incoming 7 grade students, and 396 incoming 8 grade students.

The recent Board Brief confirmed approval of three add-on positions which are anticipated to include one teacher for Spanish/World Languages, one teacher for accelerated Math, and one teacher for

accelerated ELA. While other courses like Engineering may also be popular, it is important to find a way to support every student.

A timeline for sharing more detailed information with current teachers will be set after a tentative meeting between Mr. Barwell, Dr. Wilson and Mr. Ritter on Friday, March 22.

Without final numbers to inform allocation decisions, the council agreed to postpone action.

Motion Withdrawn: To approve allocations as recommended was withdrawn by Chris Barwell. It will be important to look at course selection data collected by counselors - e.g. 267 students signed up for 7th grade Spanish, but there are only 120 available seats.

3. Adjournment

Motion Passed: Call to adjourn the meeting at 3:56 pm passed with a motion by Phil Griffin and a second by Joe Ogonek and the consensus of the council.
