Additionally, the budget discussion of "wants" in the classroom regarding Math Frax where fourth graders wrote letters to the principal expressing their desire to purchase, as well as fifth grade teachers discussing how excited students were to use Frax and take the place of XTra Math. (At a cost of \$8000+/- this is a concern but we are working hard to provide for both teachers and students.) Also, other programs discussed was the purchase of IXL, as well as a want for Social Studies Weekly which is a \$1500 cost that we will try to work within the budget. Money is tight. Contingency funding is being saved for future curriculum books to be purchased next year, which is a large cost and funding will also be needed with district help.

In other funding discussions, logo graphics were discussed as well. Quotes are being discussed and will be shared at a later date. The graphics will go in the grade level pods as well as the main hallway of the school. Examples were given of the graphics.
