Mr. Thorpe provided the board with information about various meetings he has attended in the past month.

He also updated the board on education related bills being considered by the state legislature during its current session:

- HB 737 (end all NTI days)
- HB 48 (reduce red tape law) CDIP, CSIP
- HB 132 (home/hospital starts on day 1 not after 5 days out)
- HB 240 (Kindergarten students must meet minimum standards or they SHALL be retained for a 2nd year.
- SB 9 (staff can only carry over 12 days a year)

B. Instructional Report

a. Final Cognia Report and Findings

Supervisor of Instruction Jackie Reid told the board

we received the full Cognia Accreditation Engagement Review report outlining our strengths and areas for continuous improvement. The reviewers noted the following as a strength: "The leaders of Marshall County Schools commit to the mission, vision, and core principles that guide decision-making. These guiding principles, addressed at each board of education meeting, found in handbooks, displayed in schools, and described in the Graduate Profile, support the well-being of all learners in decision-making." Areas noted for growth include:

- Identify and implement opportunities for meaningful stakeholder involvement in decision-making.
- Develop and implement an active learning model for instruction to increase learner engagement.
- Create, formalize, and implement a systemic process for identifying and interpreting various data sources.

As a result, we have identified the following next steps to continue our journey of continuous growth and improvement:

- * Formal stakeholder feedback system and structure
- * Development of local accountability committee
- * Instructional focus on student engagement and agency
- * Training and emphasis on diverse learning in each academic system

C. Attendance/Safety Report

DPP Brent Lovett told the board attendance dropped in January as a result of widespread sickness. BES had the highest percentage at 94.75%.
