Jackie Reid informed the board that our end of the year STAR results show continued steady growth in almost all grade levels in both math and reading. With the exception of 6th grade math, each grade level and content area increased in percentage of students reaching proficiency from where they began the school year. Our goal is to have an 80%+ proficiency and growth rate for all students. We are currently sitting at 60% or higher in all areas, but we have yet to hit the 80% mark consistently. This will continue to be our goal as we work to add high-quality instructional resources at all grade levels K - 12 in the upcoming years.
