16. Russell County Regional Agri-Business Training Center "Seed Academy" Funding

Rationale:

Attached is a preliminary budget/cost opinion for the Russell County Regional Agri-Business Training Center (Seed Academy). The proposed budget is \$5,104,973 with Russell County Schools contributing \$100,000 towards the project. The proposed funding sources are as follows:

We have previously discussed the training center but no formal action has been taken. Now that funding has been secured from the state legislature to fulfill the project the board needs to formally approve the \$100,000 contribution. The facility will be constructed under the direction of the Russell County

Industrial Development Authority and then turned over to the Russell County Board of Education for use. Somerset Community College is also interested in partnering to offer an agricultural based post-secondary pathway.
