For the 12th consecutive year, the board of directors of the Kentucky School Boards Association will fund two \$2,500 scholarships for eligible Kentucky high school seniors to attend any two- or four-year accredited college or university. One scholarship each will be awarded to a male and a female student. These nonrenewable scholarships will be paid directly to the institution of higher education upon the recipients official admission acceptances. Eligible students are those who would be the first members of their immediate families (parents, guardians, siblings) to complete degree requirements from an institution of higher education. Eligibility must be affirmed and signed by the high school guidance counselorandthe school district's board chairpersonandsuperintendent. I recommend weparticipate in the KSBA First Degree College Scholarship Program.
