E. Tax Rate Discussion

Order #2022-1049 - Motion Passed: Motion that the Board of Education intends to consider adopting an additional 5 cent equivalent tax rate on real and personal property, which will produce the equivalent revenue of five cents (\$.05) per one hundred dollars (\$100) of property assessed (“The Nickel Equivalent”). For the 2022-23 fiscal year, the District’s five cent equivalent rate is 6.0 cents. The District’s five cent equivalent rate changes each fiscal year and may be higher or lower when applied to future tax bills. I am asking the board to make a motion for a tax rate increase that will accomplish the needs of the district while being considerate of the taxpayers. The nickel tax will increase our bonding potential by \$8,460,000. Once the legislature matches in FY27 it would increase to \$12,820,000. This would allow for a renovation of the high school or address other capital needs as they arise. Due to the increase in SEEK, we feel that we can implement the nickel for taxpayers to only have a 4 cent increase vs. the traditional 6 cent increase.
