Winter MAP Testing is going on currently. All K-4 kids take reading and math and are able to compare their progress against their fall tests. We have a school wide initiative for students to self-monitor this. Parents are also made aware of course.

Excitement is in the air with the Christmas season upon us. The kids are going to be taking part in our annual "Santa's Shop" experience this week. Our PTA and a small army of volunteers help kids handle their money and make decisions on items to purchase for family members.

Last week (week of Dec 3rd) our PTA helped our students in our AR Store which is sort of like a "Chuck E Cheese" style prize-for-AR points system. Kids who've taken an AR test get points based on how many correct questions they get. The points accumulate and are able to be "spent" at the store.

Thanks to Mrs. Sisson (music teacher) for putting on our Holiday Talent Show Dec 10th. We had nearly 20 acts. Everyone did a fantastic job!


Currently at WVES we have NCKC basketball, Hookshots Archery, Science Club and Quick Recall in season.

Our first 6 week session of ESS just wrapped up and we'll begin again after Christmas Break. We served 47 students in grades 1-4.

The Elementary School Improvement Plan for 2019-2020 was approved at SBDM meeting on Dec 11th. The 4 areas required in our SIP are goals for growth, "gap," transition readiness, and proficiency.

Our faculty will be spending our early release time discussing our PLC protocols and also reestablishing classroom assessment "item analysis" which is the process of looking at test questions for validity, reliability and deciding if the question is truly assessing the desired learning target.

RTI round 2 meetings to take place Friday the 14th. Our students in our intervention program will be discussed as far as progress. This is a great time to get a mid-year peak at whether or not novice "gap" reduction efforts are working.



Walton-Verona High School School Board Report December 2018


Congratulations to Sarah Horn, Art Teacher who has earned the title of "National Board Certified Teacher." This involved a one year process where Mrs. Horn had to submit unit plans, assessments, examples of student work and many reflective pieces. In addition to submitting a portfolio that met or exceeded expectations, she also had to pass a test at the end of the school year. The process is so intense that it takes six months for results to be returned to the teacher candidate. Only forty percent of teachers who start the National Board Certification process are successful in earning the title. Only ten percent of teachers in the country have earned their National Board Certification! We appreciate her dedication to her profession and congratulate her on this amazing accomplishment!!

Our students gathered for an all school assembly on Wednesday, November 28th to listen to motivational speaker and former high school teacher and coach, Bobby Petrocelli. His message is "You Matter" - he has taken a tragic situation in his life and has turned it in to a powerful message for students. The students were well behaved and very attentive during this assembly. Special thanks to John Hoffman from State Farm, for reaching out to our school and providing for us this opportunity.

On November 20th, our Seniors attended "Apply Day." All seniors rotated through four sessions geared towards life after high school.
