# II.C. Reports

#### II.C.1. Superintendent Report

Mr. Watts stated he has gone out to the schools for walk-throughs, he has been impressed with the energy and effort of the teachers. Mr. Watts said he was proud, and it is greatly appreciated. Mr. Watts reported we have finished 65 days of school. Mr. Watts wants to wish everyone a Happy Thanksgiving. We

have 3 more days of school and will have one week of school off at Thanksgiving, take time to remember to count your blessing and be thankful. We need to finish the week strong with attendance. We do need some additional help for our students and staff. Mr. Hall is hosting his first basketball game. We just got the district's financial audit back. Mr. Watts discussed shopping with the cop's schedule and school.

# II.C.2. Council For Better Education Report

Report shared with the board in the work session about the gap in funding. Essential 10 Talking points:

- Additional funding is needed just to restore SEEK funding to 2008 buying power, adjusted for annual inflation per the Consumer Price Index (CPI).
- The SEEK base was \$3,822 in 2008 and in 2023, the SEEK base was \$4,100, a difference of \$278 per student over this 15-year period. To match the inflationary erosion, the SEEK base should be \$5,400 in today's dollars. This represents an additional \$1,300 necessary in the SEEK base.
- $^{ullet}$  The SEEK Base serves as a derivative of the SEEK Add-On's which also provide essential funding for schools, including State Tier 1.
- SEEK Transportation funding, which is required by the Kentucky Revised Statutes (KRS) as a reimbursement of actual expenditures, remains funded at 69% of the district's cost.
- $^{\circ}$  We appreciate the Legislature's assistance last biennium to increase the SEEK transportation funding to 69% of the cost. Still, we are not funded by the remaining 31% the law requires.
- We recognize that an additional \$1,300 per pupil to the SEEK base is a large amount and could happen over a 2 4-year period, but we need a commitment to this as a minimum due to the current status. We did not get here overnight, and it is understandable that we cannot resolve this underfunding overnight.
- Additional funding needs to go into the SEEK formula so that it will flow into the districts' General Fund, where approximately 85% of district expenditures are for salaries and related employee benefits.
- This funding allows all education staff to receive an adequate, necessary raise as is being discussed by various statewide education groups. We must be competitive with the marketplace and KY teachers deserve to earn an adequate wage based on the critical roles they play in developing KY's children.
- We do appreciate the Legislature's efforts to fully fund the TRS pension plan as this has made a significant financial difference. However, we must find a way to continue the TRS funding and ensure that our students have the full, inflationary adjusted funding required to provide an excellent education.
- · It's time to restore State SEEK to its 2008 buying power.

Mrs. Johnson, DPP, discussed month 4 for attendance. Overall, as a district 90.16. This is an early board meeting, but this is part of it. Broken down 90.28 by school SES 90.26.

# II.C.4. Academic Report

Mr. Wooton, Chief Academic Director, discussed the Academic report. He thanked the board for the investment the board has made in the curriculum. The bright spots were discussed from the newest to the veteran staff. Alot of good things going on in the district and expect to see good growth. HTS is a blue school 89.7. SES lost their TSI status. Each principal discussed the sate assessment result content area by schools.

- Highland-Turner Elementary offers responsive tiered instruction with a fluid grouping of students to meet the needs of their current level while maintaining a rigorous learning environment that fosters growth and development.
- Highland-Turner Elementary has utilized small group instruction for every student in reading and mathematics daily. Teachers, instructional assistants, and certified tutors have been properly trained to meet the academic needs of our students.
- Teachers provide tutoring to students during the planning and in an after-school setting.

- $\bullet$  Our percentage of students scoring proficient or distinguished in reading raised from 30% to 36% and in math raised from 23% to 31%
- Our percentage of students scoring novice in science was 11%.

- $\bullet$  The percentage of students scoring proficient or distinguished in social studies raised from 23% to 39%
- $\bullet$  The disability gap group increased their reading and math indicator score from 26.1 to 47.1 and with growth factored in the overall indicator was 68.1
