5. Vision & Hearing Impairment Contractual Services

Per the request of Esther Brady, Director of Special Education, the Vision & Hearing Impairment Contractual Services agreement was removed from the agenda due to the applicant backing out.

Screens and referrals for ESL Enrollment and Assessment, Health Services, School Counseling, Family Resource, Project Home, and Transportation Services may be completed as part of the enrollment.
