Decision

Accept Agreed Order stating

Certificate Number 201169103 shall be revoked for seven (7) years from December 21st, 2024 to December 20th, 2031. McHone shall not be actively employed in a certified position during the revocation period. Pursuant to KRS 161.020(1)(a): No person shall be eligible to hold the position of principal, teacher, superintendent, supervisor, director of pupil personnel, or other public-school position for which certificates may be issued, or receive salary for services rendered in the position, unless he or she holds a certificate of legal qualifications for the position, issued by the Education Professional Standards Board. McHone acknowledges it is her responsibility to consult with her employer to determine any consequences to salary or employment benefits as a result of this agreement.

- b. McHone is hereby reprimanded for her lack of professional judgement regarding her discipline of her own child in the presence of other students. McHone is reminded that as a certified educator she is required to meet high ethical standards as defined by the Professional Code of Ethics for Kentucky School Certified Personnel.
- On or before December 20th, 2031, McHone shall c. provide written proof to the Board that she has been assessed by a state-certified mental health counselor, as approved by the Board, and is fit to return to the classroom, presents as capable of performing her duties as an educator, is not a danger to herself or others, and is compliant with all treatment recommendations. The assessment shall occur within the ninety (90) days prior to Respondent's submission of the assessment to the Board. At the Board's request, McHone shall sign a release of information with the evaluating provider(s) referred to herein, allowing the Board to review her evaluation and treatment records. Any expense required for assessment and follow-up shall be paid for by McHone. Certificate Number 201169103 shall not be reissued until such condition is satisfied.
- d. On or before December 20th, 2031, McHone shall provide written proof to the Board that she has been assessed by a state-certified mental health counselor, as approved by the Board, and has complied with a comprehensive anger management assessment, and is compliant with all treatment recommendations. The assessment shall occur within the ninety (90) days prior to Respondent's submission of the assessment to the Board. At the Board's request, McHone shall sign a release of information with the evaluating provider(s) referred to herein, allowing the Board to review her evaluation and treatment records. Any expense required for assessment and follow-up shall be paid for by McHone. Certificate Number 201169103 shall not be reissued until such condition is satisfied.
- e. On or before December 20th, 2031, McHone shall submit written proof to the Board that she has completed the following training courses on the

attached pre-approved Board training list (Attachment A):

- 1) Any one (1) course under the "Classroom Management" heading;
- 2) Any one (1) course under the "Educator Ethics" heading; and
- 3) Any one (1) course under the "Appropriate Boundaries" heading.

Any cost for said trainings shall be paid for by McHone. If McHone fails to satisfy any portion of this condition, Certificate Number 201169103 shall not be reissued until such condition is satisfied.

- f. Upon reissuance of Certificate 201169103, Certificate Number 201169103, and any future endorsements or new areas of certification, shall be subject to the following probationary conditions for ten (10) years:
 - 1) During the probationary period, McHone shall not receive any disciplinary action from any school district in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. "Disciplinary action" is defined suspension, as any termination, or public reprimand issued by any school district in the Commonwealth of Kentucky and upheld, if requested, by either the tribunal and/or arbitration process, including any appeal therefrom. Resigning in lieu of termination shall also be a violation of this condition. Should McHone fail to satisfy this condition. Certificate Number 201169103 shall be automatically suspended for a period of sixty (60) days and be subject to additional sanctions by the Board pursuant to KRS 161.120.

- 2) If the fit for duty evaluation ongoing recommends treatment, McHone shall submit written progress reports from the statecertified mental health counselor on July 1st of each year of the probation, indicating that she is compliant with all treatment recommendations, until she is released from treatment. If McHone fails to satisfy any of these conditions. Certificate Number 201169103 shall be administratively suspended until such conditions are satisfied.
- 3) If the evaluating anger management counselor makes any treatment recommendations regarding anger management, McHone shall submit written progress reports to the Board on July 1st each year of the probation, indicating that she is compliant with all treatment recommendations until the counselor releases her from treatment. McHone shall pay any expense incurred. If McHone fails to satisfy any of these conditions, Certificate Number 201169103 shall be administratively suspended until such conditions are satisfied.
- g. McHone is aware that should she violate KRS 161.120 in the future, the Board shall initiate a new disciplinary action and seek additional sanctions.

2. 2456283 Jason Burgess 2456284

Accept Agreed Order stating upon acceptance of this agreement by the Board, Certificate number 200702521 is retroactively suspended beginning July 1, 2024 to July 1, 2026. Burgess shall not be actively employed in a certified position during the suspension period. Pursuant to KRS 161.020(1)(a): No person shall be eligible to hold the position of superintendent, principal, teacher, supervisor, director of pupil personnel, or other public-school position for which certificates may be issued, or receive salary for

services rendered in the position, unless he or she holds a certificate of legal qualifications for the position, issued by the Education Professional Standards Board. Burgess acknowledges it is his responsibility to consult with his employer to determine any consequences to salary or employment benefits as a result of this agreement.

Prior to reinstatement, Burgess shall submit written proof to the Board that he has completed the following trainings or courses on the attached pre-approved Board training list (Attachment A):

- 1. Two (2) courses under the "Educator Ethics" heading; and
- 2. Fiscal Management Training for Kentucky School Certified Personnel

Any cost for said trainings shall be paid for by Burgess. If Burgess fails to satisfy any portion of this condition, Certificate Number 200702521 shall not be reinstated until such condition is satisfied.

Upon reinstatement, Certificate Number 200702521, and any future endorsements or new areas of certification, shall be subject to the following probationary conditions for five (5) years:

- 1. During the probationary period, Burgess shall not receive any disciplinary action from any school district in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. "Disciplinary action" is defined as any suspension, termination, or public reprimand issued by any school district in the Commonwealth of Kentucky and upheld, if requested, by either the tribunal and/or arbitration process, including any appeal therefrom. Resigning in lieu of termination shall also be a violation of this condition. Should Burgess fail to satisfy this condition, Certificate Number 200702521 shall be automatically suspended for a period of one (1) year and subject to additional sanctions by the Board pursuant to KRS 161.120.
- 2. Burgess shall submit proof by July 1st of every year of his probation that he has

completed a training that concerns financial management. In order for the training to fulfill this requirement, Burgess shall petition the Board for pre-approval of the training by following the process outlined on page 7 of the attached list under the heading "One Time Request for Training Approval" (Attachment A). Burgess shall pay any expense incurred. If Burgess fails to satisfy this condition, Certificate Number 200702521 shall be administratively suspended until such condition is satisfied.

Burgess is aware that should he violate KRS 161.120 in the future, the Board shall initiate a new disciplinary action and seek additional sanctions.
